Documentation is required to be on file for students to receive accommodations for their disability. Accommodations may be academic and/or access.

Documentation required for verification of a disability:

An evaluation by a qualified professional (medical doctor, licensed psychologist, neuropsychologist, certified learning specialist or other licensed professional who has knowledge or expertise in the area of adult disabilities).

The evaluation must include:

- Clearly stated diagnosis and description of the disability
- Standard test scores and/or percentiles proved for all normed measures
- Diagnostic summary based on a comprehensive evaluation process
- List of medications, dosages, and frequencies
- Statement of how the disability impacts daily living and/or an academic environment
- Statement of recommendation for accommodations (must be legal and appropriate).

Documentation must be current and address the student's present level of functioning.

Documentation will be treated as a medical record. Original documentation is not released without expressed written permission of the student. Accommodations must be requested by the student in a needs assessment meeting with the Director.
