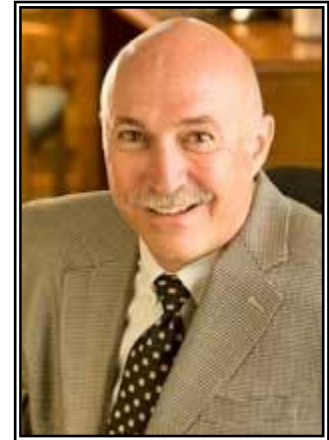


Dear Friends of St. Norbert College,

In 2008-2009, St. Norbert realized the second-best year in its history in terms of donor support for its students, programs and facilities. The College received a total of \$10.4 million in cash gifts and grants from more than 4,625 donors, a 15% increase over the previous year.

The St. Norbert Fund

The St. Norbert Fund has been devoted to providing student scholarship support and secured more than \$1.4 million from 2,790 donors from June 1, 2008 to May 31, 2009. No small college can survive on tuition income alone; private support makes financial aid available so that any qualified student can attend SNC. Annual contributions provide infinite possibilities for students, faculty, and the College as a whole, so every gift matters and every participant counts.

A New Stadium

The campaign for the new outdoor athletic complex has picked up tremendous momentum. With the assistance of committed teams of volunteers, the College has secured a total of \$7.6 million (61% of goal) for the facility and \$196,000 (20% of goal) for the maintenance endowment. We were blessed with a \$4 million naming gift from Don and Pat Schneider and we are so pleased to be able to name the new complex Donald F. Schneider Stadium. With many gifts given in memory of the late Coach Howard “Chick” Kolstad, we are naming the field, Kolstad Field in honor of his 19 year commitment as head football coach of the Green Knights.
