#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert College looks to move to 3-0 on the season when it hosts Lawrence University at Minahan Stadium. The Green Knights are 2-0 for the third time in the last four years.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 20-9-2 series lead over Lawrence. The Green Knights have won the last 11 meetings with the Vikings since a 27-24 LU win in 1997 in De Pere. Lawrence University claims only a 20-13-2 deficit in the series, but four games were played before St. Norbert began varsity inter-collegiate football in 1931.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 93-16 in his 11th season in De Pere.

Lawrence coach Chris Howard (UW-Stevens Point, 1983) is 14-26 in his fifth season in Appleton.

#### Last Meeting:

St. Norbert scored the last 28 points of the game to rally from an 18-16 second-quarter deficit to beat Lawrence 44-18 last Sept. 20 at Banta Bowl in Appleton.

The Green Knights rolled up 490 yards of total offense, with 300 coming through the air. Jeremy Gezella caught six passes for 176 yards and two touchdowns to pace St. Norbert.

Lawrence had 395 yards of total offense against St. Norbert. Nick Maxam completed 28 of 37 passes for 341 yards and three touchdowns with two interceptions.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved to 2-0 overall and 1-0 in the Midwest Conference with a 14-11 road win over Grinnell this past Saturday. The Green Knights have won 33 of their last 35 Midwest Conference games dating back to the 2005 season.

Junior running back John Weninger, who scored both St. Norbert touchdowns against Grinnell, leads the Green Knights on the ground with 195 yards on 40 attempts with two touchdowns. Junior quarterback Rob Berger has completed 37 of 64 passes for 383 yards and four touchdowns with no interceptions. Senior wide receiver Jeremy Gezella has caught 14 passes for 197 yards and two touchdowns. The Green Knights are averaging 382 yards per game of total offense.

Defensively, junior linebacker Justin Baker leads the Green Knights in tackles with 17. Junior linebacker Drew Oudenhoven has 12 tackles, while senior defensive backs Chris Manlick and Dustin Gresen have 11 tackles apiece. The Green Knights are allowing an average of 341 yards per game.

### About the Vikings:

Lawrence opened its 2009 season with a 56-3 loss to Monmouth at the Banta Bowl in Appleton this past Saturday. The Vikings have lost their last 11 Midwest Conference games.

The Vikings had eight turnovers and were held to 85 yards of total offense, including 50 yards rushing,

and three first downs by the defending conference champion. The Vikings trailed 49-0 at halftime and were 1-for-14 on third-down conversions in the game.

Jesse Peterson led the Vikings with 19 yards rushing on seven attempts, while Lucas Below had six rushes for 15 yards. Nick Maxam completed 3 of 7 passes for 16 yards with two interceptions.

Defensively, the Vikings yielded 553 yards to Monmouth, including 336 through the air. Lawrence allowed 24 first downs and an 8-for-17 third-down conversion rate.

### Grinding It Out:

St. Norbert posted 237 yards of total offense in its 14-11 win at Grinnell this past Saturday. It marked the fewest yards gained in a St. Norbert win in Jim Purtill's 11-year coaching tenure.

The Green Knights had 240 yards of total offense in a 38-28 win at Ripon on Oct. 21, 2006 for the previous low output in a St. Norbert win under Purtill.

Prior to the 237 yards against Grinnell, the fewest yards gained in a St. Norbert win were 215 on an extremely muddy field in a 27-6 win at Monmouth on Oct. 17, 1998.

### Nearing a Milestone:

St. Norbert head coach Jim Purtill is four wins shy of becoming the winningest football coach in school history.

Howard "Chick" Kolstad currently has the most win in St. Norbert gridiron coaching history, posting a 96-75-5 record in 19 seasons from 1960-78. St. Norbert operated as an independent in athletics during Kolstad's tenure, with the Green Knights defeating the likes of Western Illinois, Northern Michigan, Mankato State, Ferris

State, Hillsdale, St. Cloud State and several Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members.

Purtill has fashioned a 93-16 overall record going into the Lawrence game, good for an .853 winning percentage. The Green Knights have captured eight Midwest Conference championships in his 10 seasons and have appeared in seven NCAA Division III Playoffs.

### Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is shooting for its 11th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as seven games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and a 7-3 campaign in 2008.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 383-263-20 in 76 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .590. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 140-29, a winning percentage of .829.

In 24 years in the Midwest Conference, St. Norbert has won 12 football championships. In addition to St. Norbert, only four charter members of the MWC have won at least 10 football championships - Coe with 21, Ripon with 19, Lawrence with 16 and Cornell with 12.

### Quick Hitters:

\* - During Jim Purtill's 11-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 52 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 25-1 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game seven different times.

\* - St. Norbert has won 53 straight games when scoring at least 30 points dating back to a 41-40 loss to Illinois College on Nov. 10, 2001. St. Norbert is 163-10 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 100-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
