Game Overview:

St. Norbert opens its 80th season of intercollegiate football with a neutralsite game against John Carroll. The Green Knights take on the Blue Streaks at Toyota Park, home of Major League Soccer's Chicago Fire.

The Series:

John Carroll leads St. Norbert 1-0 in an all-time series begun last season in Dublin, Ireland.

Last Meeting:

John Carroll erased a 3-0 deficit with a 27-point second quarter and went on to defeat St. Norbert College 40-3 last Aug. 31 in the Global Ireland Football Tournament in front of a raucous crowd of 4,877 at Donnybrook Stadium in Dublin, Ireland.

John Carroll quarterback Mark Myers, a transfer from the University of Pittsburgh, set a then-school record with 457 passing yards in his first appearance with the Blue Streaks. Myers completed 30 of 43 passes with five touchdowns and one interception.

St. Norbert held a 3-0 lead after the first quarter, following Randy Hill's 39-yard field goal with 5 minutes 13 seconds left in the period.

John Carroll answered with a 14-play 97-yard drive to pull ahead 6-3 on

DaQuan Grobsmith's 1-yard run. Myers hit Randy Greenwood on a swing pass out of the backfield, and Greenwood broke free for a 73-yard touchdown for a 13-3 lead with 6:35 left before halftime.

The Blue Streaks struck a huge blow in deciding the outcome with two touchdowns in the last 1:27 of the first half. Myers twice found Lane Robilotto on 20-yard touchdown passes, the last one coming with 15 seconds left before intermission after St. Norbert bobbled a punt snap and gave the ball up on downs.

St. Norbert couldn't muster much offense, getting just 90 yards of total offense on 59 plays. Austin Williams rushed 14 times for a team-high 43 yards. James Tringali made his first collegiate start for the Green Knights, completing 12 of 25 passes for 48 yards and one interception.

John Carroll had 513 yards of total offense, with 483 coming through the air. Robilotto caught nine passes for 116 yards, while Kline added eight receptions for 143 yards.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 122-27 in his 14th season in De Pere.

John Carroll coach Tom Arth (John Carroll, 2003) is 0-0 in his first season in University Heights.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the 2013 season coming off its 14th consecutive season with at least seven wins. The Green Knights claimed their 10th Midwest Conference title in the last 14 years last season after finishing league play 8-1 and ended the season 8-3 overall.

Sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier is the Green Knights' top returning rusher after netting 430 yards on 75 carries with six touchdowns last season. Junior quarterback James Tringali completed 152 of 278 passes (54.7 percent) a year ago for 1,847 yards with 17 touchdowns and 11 interceptions. Senior wide receiver Brian

Fliess is the leading returning receiver after catching 26 passes for 365 yards and four touchdowns last season. Senior wide receiver Michael Heim caught 15 passes for 159 yards and two touchdowns last season.

Senior defensive back Anthony Parker led St. Norbert in tackles last season with 65, and was second in interceptions with two.

St. Norbert averaged 27.6 points and 311.7 yards per game last season. Defensively, the Green Knights allowed opponents 22.1 points and 321.3 yards per game.

About the Blue Streaks:

John Carroll enters its first season under new head coach Tom Arth following a 6-4 season a year ago. The Blue Streaks finished play in the rigorous Ohio Athletic Conference with a 5-4 mark.

Junior quarterback Mark Myers leads the John Carroll offense after passing for 2,882 yards with 25 touchdowns last season. Senior running back DaQuan Grobsmith had a team-high 385 rushing yards with four touchdowns. Grobsmith was second on the team in receiving last season with 40 catches for 331 yards, while senior wide receiver Alex Kline had 33 catches for 522 yards with seven touchdowns.

John Carroll averaged 31.7 points and 429.2 yards per game last season. Defensively, the Blue Streaks allowed 22.8 points and 325.3 yards per game.

Opening Day Observations:

St. Norbert has won seven of its last 13 season openers. The Green Knights lost last year's season opener to John Carroll 40-3 last Aug. 31 in Dublin, Ireland.

The first four season-opening wins in the last 13 years all came against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foes Hamline University and the University of St. Thomas. The Green Knights defeated the Pipers 34-22 in St. Paul in 2000 and won 26-22 in 2001 in De Pere. St. Norbert then beat St. Thomas 35-31 in 2002 and 21-19 in 2003. St. Norbert topped Wartburg

42-35 in overtime in 2009's lidlifter to earn a split in the two-year series.

The four MIAC games from 2000-03 were the Green Knights' first openers against a non-Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference or NCAA Division II foe since 1983, the last time SNC won an opener prior to 2000 (24-14 over Monmouth in 1983). The Green Knights opened against NCAA Division II Michigan Tech from 1984 to 1987, UW-Stevens Point in 1988 and 1989, UW-Oshkosh from 1990 to 1999, UW-Whitewater in 2004 and 2005, Olivet Nazarene in 2006 and 2007, Wartburg in 2008 and 2009 and St. Thomas again in 2010 and 2011.

St. Norbert, entering its 80th year of varsity football, is 37-36-6 in season openers.

The Green Knights are scheduled to begin a home-and-home series with Carthage to open the 2014 and 2015 seasons. The 2014 opener will be at Carthage.

Roster Diversity:

St. Norbert has 100 players listed on its roster as of Sept. 3, a decrease of 23 from the same point in time last season.

On the 2013 roster, 62 players are from Wisconsin. Illinois has the second-highest total with 17 players hailing from the Land of Lincoln. Florida is third with six players. Michigan is next with four players, and there is one each from Colorado, Minnesota and Texas.

There are three foreign players, one each from Denmark and Sweden.

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert is 184-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 112-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- * During Jim Purtill's 14-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 63 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 31-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
