topped the Green Knights 5-4 in overtime on Jan. 21, 1995 at Hobbs Ice Center.

St. Norbert is 45-11-3 all-time against St. Scholastica. St. Norbert holds a 9-5-1 series edge in its last 15 meetings with the Saints. This is the first time the two programs have met on neutral ice.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Tim Coghlin (UW-Stevens Point, 1989) is 442-119-46 in his 21st season in De Pere. The Green Knights are 297-49-29 in the last 13-plus seasons. Coghlin's 432 wins as a coach in the NCHA is the league record, 60 more than Bemidji State's Bob Peters' 370 wins. Coghlin's six NCAA championship game appearances are the second most in Division III history. Coghlin became just the 37th coach in college hockey history (all divisions) to win 400 games when St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 4-2 on Jan. 20, 2012.

UW-Eau Claire coach Matt Loen (UW-Eau Claire, 1995) is 89-73-13 in his seventh season in Eau Claire.

St. Scholastica coach Mark Wick (St. Scholastica, 1985) is 124-104-31 in his tenth season in Duluth.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert topped UW-Eau Claire 5-2 this past Friday at the Cornerstone Community Center. Pijus Rulevicius, Michael Hill, Erik Cooper, Brandon Hoogenboom and Mason Baptista all scored for the Green Knights. Jon Waggoner scored twice for the Blugolds. David Jacobson made 32 saves for the Green Knights, while Tyler Green made 27 stops for Eau Claire.

St. Norbert took season series from St. Scholastica three games to one. The road team won all three regular-season games until the Green Knights claimed a 2-1 win in the semifinals of the NCHA Peters Cup Playoffs on Feb. 23, 2013 at the Cornerstone Community Center. St. Norbert swept St. Scholastica 6-1 and 6-2 on Dec. 7-8, 2012 at Mars

Lakeview Arena in Duluth, Minn. The Saints then claimed a 5-2 win at on Feb. 1, 2013 at the Cornerstone Community Center.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 1 in both the USCHO.com and the D3hockey.com Division III polls, is 8-0 overall heading into Wednesday's game at UW-Eau Claire. The Green Knights remained unbeaten last week by topping defending national champion UW-Eau Claire 5-2 on Friday and UW-Stout 5-2 on Saturday at the Cornerstone Community Center.

Junior forward Mason Baptista paces the Green Knights in scoring with three goals and nine assists for 12 points. Sophomore forward Michael Hill has four goals and five assists for nine points, while senior forward Joe Perry has six goals and two assists for eight points. Sophomore forward Erik Cooper has totaled five goals and two assists for seven points.

Junior goaltender David Jacobson is 5-0 with a 1.60 goals against average and .921 save percentage. Freshman Tony Kujava is 3-0 with a 1.33 goals against average and .926 save percentage.

St. Norbert is 9-for-44 (20.5 percent) on the power play and is 37-for-39 (94.9 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

About the Blugolds:

UW-Eau Claire, ranked No. 4 by USCHO.com and No. 5 by D3hockey.com, enters Wednesday's game at 5-1 overall. The Blugolds suffered their last loss of the season this past Friday 5-2 at St. Norbert before bouncing back to defeat Concordia-Wis., 7-0 on Saturday.

Senior forward Jon Waggoner has four goals and four assists for eight points. Junior forward Joe Krause has three goals and five assists for eight points, while sophomore forward Charles Thauwald has two goals and six assists for eight

points. Senior forward Daniel Olszewski has one goal and six assists for seven points.

Sophomore goaltender Tyler Green is 3-1 with a 2.25 goals against average and .924 save percentage. Freshman Jay Deo is 2-0 with a 0.50 goals against average and .980 save percentage.

Eau Claire is 3-for-20 (15.0 percent) on the power play and is 26-for-27 (96.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

About the Saints:

St. Scholastica enters tonight's game at 5-1-2 overall. The Saints suffered their first loss of the season this past Saturday when it dropped a 3-2 decision against archrival UW-Superior in Duluth, Minn.

Senior forward Brandon Nowakowski leads the Saints in scoring with six goals and seven assists for 13 points, and has four power-play goals. Sophomore forward Dylan Nowakowski has five goals and six assists for 11 points. Senior forward Paul Marcoux has four goals and six assists for 10 points, while junior forward Dave Williams has three goals and four assists for seven points.

Senior goaltender Colin Rundell is 2-1-2 with a 2.91 goals against average and .905 save percentage. Sophomore Tyler Bruggeman is 3-0 with a 2.00 goals against average and .908 save percentage.

St. Scholastica is 10-for-30 (33.3 percent) on the power play and is 24-for-29 (82.8 percent) on the penalty kill this season.

WIAC Wisdom:

St. Norbert faces its third consecutive game against Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference opposition on Wednesday at UW-Eau Claire. The game is the third this season out of five against the former Northern Collegiate Hockey Association members.

St. Norbert, which entered the NCHA in 1994-95, owns 13 NCHA regular-season championships and

11 Peters Cup titles, both NCHA records. Since the 2002-03 season, the first year the Green Knights advanced to the NCAA Division III Frozen Four, St. Norbert is 128-22-16 against the WIAC schools. In program history, St. Norbert is 204-75-28 all-time against the WIAC.

Since 2002-03, St. Norbert is 29-3-1 against UW-Stevens Point, 31-4-2 against UW-Eau Claire, 25-5-1 against UW-River Falls, 22-5-3 against UW-Stout and 21-5-8 against UW-Superior.

Coghlin Count:

St. Norbert head coach Tim Coghlin brings a record of 442-119-46 into this weekend. The Green Knights' 5-2 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 23 moved Coghlin into 28th on the NCAA hockey all divisions all-time victories list.

Coghlin moved past Trinity's John Dunham (1975-2007), who was previously in 28th place with a record of 441-306-34 in 33 seasons.

Currently sitting in 27th place is Doug Ross, who totaled a 457-294-43 mark in 27 seasons combined at Ohio, Kent State and Alabama-Huntsville.

Tough After Two:

St. Norbert currently has a 38-game winning streak overall when leading after two periods. The Green Knights were 22-0 last season when leading after 40 minutes, and also won their final 11 opportunities the previous season when up after two frames. St. Norbert is 5-0 this season when leading after two periods.

Under Tim Coghlin, St. Norbert is an astounding 237-1-2 at home when up after two periods.

St. Norbert had a home unbeaten streak when leading after two periods of 200 games (197-0-3) before it was snapped by UW-Stout in a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 7, 2009 - Coghlin's only home setback when leading after two.

At home, St. Norbert is 255-2-3 in school history when leading after

two periods. The Green Knights' lone other loss when up after two periods on their own ice came on Nov. 18, 1989 in a 3-1 loss to Augsburg when St. Norbert lost a 1-0 lead.

Poll Position:

St. Norbert has been ranked in the USCHO.com Division III Poll for 213 consecutive polls. The Green Knights have been ranked in 251 of 257 polls conducted since its inception at the start of the 1998-99 season - the most of any school in Division III.

During the 213-week stretch of being ranked, St. Norbert has been No. 1 for 54 weeks - trailing Norwich's 71 for most all-time. St. Norbert was rated No. 1 in the 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2011 and 2012 final polls. The Green Knights are 73-15-6 all-time when ranked No. 1 in the USCHO.com Poll.

St. Norbert is 106-42-15 against teams ranked in the USCHO.com Poll under Tim Coghlin. The Green Knights are 2-4 all-time against the No. 1-ranked team and are 5-5 all-time against the No. 2-ranked team.

Gimme Five:

St. Norbert is unbeaten in its last 256 games when scoring five goals or more with a 249-0-7 mark since a 7-5 loss to Bemidji State in De Pere on Jan. 12, 1996.

St. Norbert is 5-23-6 in its last 34 games when allowing five goals or more dating back to the 1996-97 season. The only five wins came in a 9-5 win over St. Scholastica on Feb. 20, 1999, a 7-5 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 30, 2001, an 8-5 win over UW-Stout on Jan. 14, 2005, a 7-5 win over UW-Stevens Point on Feb. 3, 2007 and a 7-5 win over Gustavus Adolphus on Oct. 31, 2008.

The Green Knights have allowed five goals just 20 times in their last 357 games.

St. Norbert has never allowed 10 goals in a game during Tim Coghlin's 607-game tenure.
