

REQUIREMENTS TO COMPLETE THE ESL PROGRAM

The ESL Institute offers three program certificates:

1. Completion of the ESL program with recommendation to SNC degree program
2. Completion of the ESL program
3. Certificate of Participation

I. ESL completion with recommendation to degree program:

Students wishing to receive a certificate of program completion with a recommendation to begin a full-time degree program at St. Norbert College need to complete the following courses:

- a. Advanced Academic Reading (ESL 92)
- b. Advanced Academic Writing (ESL 93)
- c. Lecture and Note-taking (ESL 91)
- d. Issues for Debate and Discussion (ESL 96)

College-bound students must earn a minimum grade of "BC" in these courses. In addition, college-bound students must observe college lecture classes and then demonstrate to the professor that he/she understood the lecture and was able to take accurate notes.

II. Certificate of ESL Completion:

Students wishing to receive a certificate of program completion (without a recommendation for college courses) need to complete the following courses:

- a. Advanced Academic Reading (ESL 92)
- b. Advanced Academic Writing (ESL 93)
- c. Any two listening/speaking course with a course number of "80" or higher.

III. Certificate of Participation

The Certificate of Participation is given to students who made satisfactory progress in their classes, but the advanced level courses were not completed.
