## St. Norbert College International Student Scholarships and Awards

### Tuition Scholarships:

St. Norbert College offers merit-based tuition scholarships to highly qualified foreign students who apply to study in a degree program at St. Norbert College. Award decisions are made after application documents are received and the applicant's file is complete. Awards are renewable each year on condition the student remains in good academic standing. No separate application is required for award consideration.

Secondary school (high school) grades must be from a challenging college preparatory curriculum. Students who complete a technical school program are not considered for admission. Merit-based awards use a 4.0 grading system where 4.0 is the highest possible cumulative grade point average (GPA). Student grades are converted to this system during the admissions process.

Scholarship awards are based upon cumulative high school GPA. Demonstrated financial need and special achievements may also be considered. Scholarship awards are announced in the admission acceptance letter. Once a scholarship offer has been officially offered and accepted by the student, the award cannot be increased. Additionally, international students may apply for jobs on campus.

### SNC Leadership Awards:

The International Student Leadership Award is based on an applicant's participation in extra-curricular, leadership and volunteer opportunities. Participation in these activities can be documented in two ways:

1. Send a copy of the award or certificate along with a letter of recommendation from the coordinator or manager of the event or activity.
2. Send an essay outlining the impact these activities have had your life and how it will influence your time at St. Norbert College.

Successful candidates for these awards will demonstrate a link between their leadership experiences and their vision for their future. The maximum leadership award is \$6,000 each academic year. Awards are renewable for four years. A limited number of leadership awards are available. Awards are given contingent upon date of application and availability of funds. Submit your SNC admission application early! No special award application is required.

### **SNC Need-Based Grants:**

Need-based grants may be offered to exceptional students who demonstrate significant financial need. To be considered for a need-based grant, submit the College Board's "International Student Financial Aid Application" along with documents showing estimated family funds and funds from sponsors. Also, send a letter or essay explaining why you should receive this award. The maximum need-based award is \$6,000 each academic year. Awards are renewable for four years. A limited number of need-based awards are available. Awards are given based upon date of application and availability of funds. Submit your SNC admission application early! No special award application is required.
