

## Saint Norbert College Fact Sheet for International Students

### Admission to Degree Programs:

We encourage applications from well-qualified students from all nations. To apply for admission, please mail to us these documents:

- A completed application with financial statements and application fees.
- Your high school and university (if any) academic records with English translation.
- One of the following test scores to show us your English language ability:  
TOEFL: iBT: 80  
IELTS: 6.0 - 6.5
- **Dual (conditional) Admission:**  
We offer dual admission to students who are qualified for admission, but who do not have a TOEFL score or whose score is below our requirement. These students may need to attend our non-credit ESL program before beginning a degree program. (<http://www.snc.edu/esl>)
- Send one letter of recommendation.
- Transfer students may apply for transfer credit after they arrive and register for classes. There is a \$150 evaluation fee for an outside agency to review your university transcript.

The Dean of Enrollment reviews completed applications on a rolling basis. In general, students offered direct admission to St. Norbert College possess an acceptable TOEFL score and a "B" average in a challenging high school curriculum.

### Scholarships

A limited number of merit scholarships are available up to \$12,000 per year. Exceptional students may also qualify for leadership grants of up to \$6,000 per year.

### Student Visa

Upon acceptance, a SEVIS I-20 will be sent to the prospective student. The student must pay the \$200 SEVIS "I-901" fee before making an appointment for a visa interview at the nearest U.S. embassy or consulate.

St. Norbert College is a Catholic, liberal arts and sciences college affiliated with the Norbertines, a Catholic religious order committed to education and service. The College offers bachelor's degrees in arts, science, music, and business administration in more than 30 areas of study.
