Throughout the year we will host a series of presentations to recognize professional achievement in scholarship and to celebrate the rich diversity and talents of our colleagues.

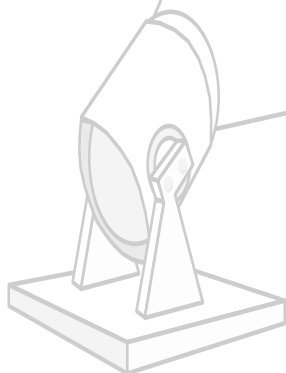
This Spotlight on Scholarship features

“You can’t always get what you want...”
How reactions that did not work lead to new chemistry

Stepping into the lab during the Fall 2008 semester, Kari’s sabbatical project was the design and synthesis of novel photochemically active compounds, which is to say her research goal was utilizing light to create chemical energy. She assumed that previous, successful methods would lead to new chemical compounds of interest; however, that was not the case. She will discuss how unsuccessful syntheses created a new path to some truly interesting chemistry.
