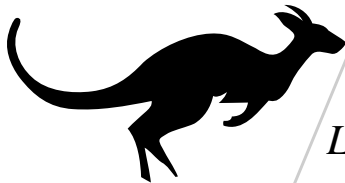

Return to the
Lands of the Lightning Brothers:
Djangurrul

Travel with Professor Chuck Peterson 12,000 miles and 10,000 years back in time to a remote area in Australia's Northern Territory. In July 2003 Chuck made his third journey to the traditional lands of the Aboriginal Wardaman people to continue recording the magnificent rock art images, oral tradition, and music of the tribe. Chuck was given the skinship name, Djangurrul, and by Wardaman tradition became the brother of Yidunduma, leader of the tribe. While bush camping with Yidunduma, he was taken to rock shelters never before shown to a *white fella*. You will visit some of the world's finest rock art sites and hear an elder tell creation stories, play the didgeridoo, and sing traditional songs. You will also hear animal stories including one about the kangaroo that stole Chuck's new tripod.
