Spotlight On Scholarship

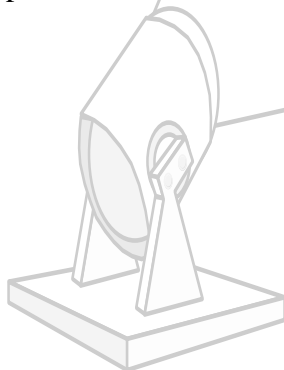
Throughout the year we will host a series of presentations to recognize professional achievement in scholarship and to celebrate the rich diversity and talents of our colleagues.

Associate Professor of Biology

Evidence of Directional Selection From the Fossil Record of
Leptotomus parvus (Rodentia: Ischyromyidae) of the Bridger Formation,
Green River Basin, Wyoming

Deborah Anderson will present evidence from her recently completed (Spring 2004) research project. This evidence reveals an increase in molar size for fossil rodents from the Green River Basin in Wyoming that occurred over a period of 600,000 MA. The research was conducted, in part, in collaboration with SNC undergraduate students.
