**“Reinventing the Wheel or Reinflating the Tire:
Thoughts on the Process of Reengaging in Scholarship”**

Over the course of a career in academia, the scholarly activity of some faculty may be interrupted or limited due to professional and/or personal circumstances. If such is the case, how then does one go about jump-starting their scholarship? This talk will focus on the process of reestablishing a scholarly agenda following a lull in activity. Rather than focus exclusively on Tim’s topical research (geochemistry of Philippine volcanoes and the corresponding implications for the origin of continental crust), four contrasting areas will be explored; topical research, pedagogical research, student/faculty collaborative research and grant-writing.
