From Plan to Market –
Teaching Economics in Countries of the former Soviet Union

The collapse of the Soviet Union more than a decade ago created a sea of change for many countries that are now making the transition from “command” decision-making to systems based on free markets. The economic waves of change rolling through these nations called for a swift and strong response. In the United States, the National Council on Economic Education (NCEE) answered that call with multiple programming efforts on the education front. Economics Professor Sandy Odorzynski has been involved with these initiatives since 1995. Travel with Sandy to Belarus, Ukraine, Slovakia, Russia, and other Eastern European countries to discover how economic literacy is being spread and reinforced one teacher at a time in classrooms ranging from the elementary to the university.
