Admission Policy

St. Norbert College encourages applications from all ethnic, religious and racial backgrounds. The St. Norbert admission staff remains committed to reviewing each application individually, paying particular attention to the unique attributes each student possesses. The College operates under a rolling admission plan where applications are reviewed as they are received; applications will be considered as long as space remains available.

Freshman Admission Procedure

The following documents are required to complete the freshman admission process:

- Part I of the attached application completed by you.
- A \$25 application fee payable to St. Norbert College (\$10 if you apply online, see address to right).
- Official high school transcripts of all completed course work, including rank-in-class (if available), and ACT/SAT results.
- Part II of the application completed by your guidance counselor.
- One letter of recommendation.
- Personal statement.

Use the attached envelope to mail these documents to St. Norbert College's Office of Admission.

Transfer Admission Procedure

The following documents are required to complete the transfer admission process:

- Part I of the attached application completed by you.
- A \$25 application fee payable to St. Norbert College (\$10 if you apply online, see address above right).
- Official high school transcripts of all completed course work, including rank-in-class (if available), and ACT/SAT results.
- Official college transcripts from each college or university you have attended.
- One letter of recommendation.
- Personal statement.

Common Application for Admission

St. Norbert College is a member of the Common Application, a select group of 300 private colleges and universities that accept the Common Application. As a Common Application member, St. Norbert encourages its use and gives equal consideration to the Common Application and our own application form. Students using the Common Application complete one application and personal statement, then submit them to member institutions electronically or in hard copy. This procedure simplifies the college application process by saving time and eliminating unnecessary duplication of effort. The Common Application can be completed or downloaded from the Common Application web site (www.commonapp.org).

Apply Online

Students may complete the admission process online at www.snc.edu/futurestudents/apply. The standard \$25 application fee is reduced to \$10 for students who apply online. The submission of official transcripts, ACT/SAT scores, a personal statement and a counselor recommendation must be sent separate from the application to complete the application process.

Unique Situations

HOME-SCHOOLED STUDENTS

We use the same criteria to evaluate home-schooled applicants as we do for all others. If you are a student who has been home-schooled at any point during your high school years, the traditional application process should be followed. Additional supporting materials and an on-campus interview with a St. Norbert admission representative are encouraged.

PART-TIME STUDENTS

If you intend to enroll as a part-time student, you must still submit a complete application for admission and all relevant transcripts.

NON-DEGREE SEEKING STUDENTS

Students who do not wish to pursue a degree but are seeking enrichment and skills in a specific course will be admitted on an individual basis. You must complete the non-degree student course registration form and return the completed application to the registrar's office. They, in turn, will register you for the class.
