We arrived in Zambia five days ago. Our journey is just beginning! We had a wet and wondrous trip to the magnificent Victoria Falls. It is over 1 mile wide making it the largest curtain of water in the world. It drops between 295-351 feet into the Zambezi Gorge. March and April is the peak of flood season. During this time, columns of spray from the falls can be seen from miles away. An amazing 546 million cubic meters of water plummet over the edge each minute.
