Move in Process

Move in day for new students is Thursday, August 27th beginning at 8:00 am. FYE mentors will be in green shirts directing vehicles where to park upon arrival. Students and parents should stay in their cars at all times until directed where to go. While waiting for an open parking space, students can fill out personal data forms. Once released from the parking lot, students need to unload all belongings and move vehicles as soon as possible. After parking the car, students should go directly into their assigned Residence Hall to check in and receive the Week of Welcome (WOW) schedule, ID card, and room keys.

Loft Pick up

Pre-ordered lofts can be picked up from 8:00 am - 2:00 pm at 4 different distribution sites across campus: VMC, Sensenbrenner, Mad/Lor, and Bergstrom. Bright green loft signs will be directing students where to go. The REH Loft Crew will also be in bright green shirts, so feel free to ask for assistance at any time. Students can pick up lofts after unloading the car and checking in. Students should bring family, friends, or roommates to help move the loft as there are several pieces to pick up. Setting up lofts can be confusing, so the REH office has created some loft set up videos to aid students and their families in the set up process. Residence Hall Meeting

All students residing in a Residence Hall must attend the mandatory first Hall meeting where they will meet the RAs and other residents on their floor. The meeting will take place on Thursday night, August 27th. During the meeting, students will be signing Roommate contracts and learning the general workings of each floor and specific details about Residence Hall living. Any questions about Residence Halls can be asked at this time.

Commuter Student Meeting

The meeting for commuter status students will take place in the Campus Center Fireplace Lounge from 6:00 pm - 7:00 pm. This is a general informational session which will allow commuter students to ask questions and learn more about commuting to St. Norbert College.



What about Mail?

Students can pick up a mail key and suite box number from the Mail Center, located in the basement of the Sensenbrenner Memorial Union. This key and suite will be used all four years. All mailboxes are located in the Ray Van Den Heuvel Campus Center.

Hit the Books

Be sure to pick up all your books for class at the bookstore, open from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm. The bookstore also offers school supplies as well as SNC clothing and other paraphernalia.

Take a Break!

After moving all day long, students and families will need to take a break. Stop by the Misting tents for water and refreshments. Also, help SNC go green by bringing extra cardboard boxes to recycle.

Housing Contract

Students must read and sign a housing contract before moving into their Residence Halls.
