Applications for Pi Mu Epsilon, the national honorary mathematics society, are being accepted until April 11. To be eligible for membership, you must:

1. Have an overall cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
2. Have passed at least four college mathematics classes (calculus or higher) with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00. If you started your math at SNC beyond Calculus I, the courses that you received credit for by taking them in high school will be considered an "A."
3. Be a member of the Sigma Nu Delta Math Club. (You can join the Math Club when you apply for PME.)
4. Pay a once-in-a-lifetime fee of \$25 and the applicable membership fee for the Math Club (\$7 for a year, \$4 for one semester).
