

Commonly asked questions regarding overnight sibling registration during Family Weekend...

Question 1:

How do I register my children to stay with their older brothers or sisters during the Family Weekend?

A: All registration for siblings wishing to stay with their older siblings can be done on the Family Weekend registration form or during the RHA sponsored activities on Friday night and Sat. morning. No pre registration is appreciated. All individuals must sign liability waivers in order to participate in the weekend's events.

Question 2:

Are there any age requirements for how old siblings must be in order to stay within the Residence Halls?

A: There is no real age limit that a student must be before he/she is allowed to stay with their older siblings. However, one stipulation does exist. If the individual is below 13 years of age, they will be allowed to stay in their older sibling's room, no matter what the sex of the roommates in the room is. If, however, the younger sibling is 13 years of age or above, they must stay in a room with individuals of the same sex.

Question 3:

Are there any costs to have a younger sibling stay in the room of an SNC student?

A: There is no fee to have the siblings stay in the room with the students, however, they must register with the Residence Hall Association, and the R.A. of the student must be informed that a guest is staying in the room for the weekend.

Questions 4:

What are the younger siblings required to sign a liability form?

A: The Residence Hall Association is sponsoring activities for the students and their younger siblings throughout the entire weekend. Some of these activities include inflatable rides, tie-dying, video games, and scavenger hunts. The liability forms are so that the student will take responsibility for their actions during these activities and will not hold the college responsible for any problems that could occur while participating in these activities.
