The Henke Peace and Justice Fund Scholarship

Purpose:

The Henke Peace and Justice Fund has been established through the generosity of Dianne Stark Henke ('71), to support SNC students with financial assistance to study, practice, and promote peace and justice through curricular and co-curricular programs. Two \$1000 Scholarships for the next academic year are available through this fund to eligible candidates.

Eligibility:

Eligible candidates will need to meet the following criteria:

- + Successful completion of at least one year of study at SNC;
- + Active involvement in programs offered by and/or endorsed by the St. Norbert College Peace and Justice Center;
- + Ability to articulate an understanding of peace and justice issues;
- + Cumulative GPA of at least 2.5.

Application Instructions:

1. Applications are available in the SNC Peace and Justice Center, Sensenbrenner Memorial Union or online at www.snc.edu/pjc/scholarships.htm.
2. Complete The Henke Peace and Justice Fund Scholarship application and return it to the SNC Peace and Justice Center by February 15, 2007.
3. Submit a statement on separate paper describing personal strengths and interests related to Peace and Justice issues and involvement in such activity.
4. Request a current official transcript of grades and credits to be sent by the Registrar's Office directly to the Director of the Peace and Justice Center.
5. Submit two personal references, at least one of which should be a SNC Faculty/Staff member. References should be sent directly to the Director of the Peace and Justice Center.

Special Note:

The \$1000 Scholarship is neither based on financial need, nor should it amend any financial assistance already awarded to the candidate(s).

Provided all other scholarship requirements are met, candidates who have declared a minor in Peace and Justice studies shall be given first consideration.

No SNC student is precluded from applying (in accord with above criteria).

The Director of Financial Aid will review the financial profile of the student(s) selected to ensure Federal and State guidelines and standards are maintained for the benefit of the student(s).
