CRN	Course Id	Course Title	Course Description
3096	ART 389-A	Special Topics: 3-D Mixed Media	Students will explore inventive and experimental approaches to a variety of media, both traditional and nontraditional. Students initially work with collage, then advance to more conceptual projects using found objects, text and image, and photomontage. Intuitive and creative uses of traditional materials are explored, as well as boundaries between painting and sculpture. Intermediate level studio course.
3114	BIOL 489-A	Special Topics: Animal Behavior	The study of animal behavior provides, among other things, a means for scientists to understand the evolutionary, developmental, or physiological bases of behavior, to ensure animal welfare and conservation, or to generalize phenomena observed in animals to humans. The discipline is a broad one, with contributions from diverse fields like ecology, anthropology, comparative psychology, zoology and physiology. This course is designed to examine, in and among countless species, the following: animal communication, antipredator behavior, learning, foraging behaviors, cultural transmission, mate choice and mating systems, cooperation, aggression and territoriality, migration, play, and the evolution of these behaviors. The laboratory portion of the course will consist almost entirely of observation and the presentation of techniques to assess behavior in the field and the lab. Prerequisites: Biol 120 and Biol 121
3115	BIOL 489-B	Special Topics: Biology of the Cancer Cell	This course will cover the cell and molecular biology of cancer cells. Attention will be given to the six characteristics of cancer cells defined by Hanahan and Weinberg: Self-sufficiency in growth signals, insensitivity to growth-inhibitory signals, evasion of apoptosis, limitless replicative potential, sustained angiogenesis, and metastasis. The role of signal transduction pathways, chemical carcinogens and viruses in carcinogenesis will be discussed. Strategies and mechanisms of cancer treatments will be introduced. The laboratory component of the course will include the maintenance of cancer cell lines and their use in guided lab exercises and independent research projects. Students may be required to perform some lab activities outside of regularly-scheduled times. Prerequisite: "C" or better in BIOL 244.
3140	BUAD 489-A	Special Topics: Social Entrepreneurship	This course provides students with an understanding of the complex dynamics underlying Social Entrepreneurship as a global phenomenon. Social Entrepreneurship is about using entrepreneurial skills to craft innovative responses to social problems. It aims at social impact but does not exclude economic wealth creation. Thus it is not limited to the non-profit sector. Social Entrepreneurship involves recognizing opportunities, combining resources, triggering positive change in various domains, and building sustainability. Fulfills Management Concentration Emphasis or General Business Advanced elective.
3173	COME 389-A	Special Topics: Health Communications	This course is intended to provide students information regarding one of the fastest growing areas in the discipline of communication. It examines a variety of issues and theories related to health including communication about health issues, communication in the health care industry, health campaigns and more. 3266	ENGL 489-A	Adv Sem Engl Literary Studies: Charles Dickens	In this capstone course we will examine the evolution of Dickens, from a struggling reporter to the great comic novelist of the Victorian age. Works may include Oliver Twist (1838), David Copperfield (1850), Bleak House (1853), Hard Times (1854), Great Expectations (1861), and The Mystery of Edwin Drood (1870). We will read one of the novels in serial form, mirroring the publication history of Dickens's novels, and watch major film adaptations of select novels. The course will be discussion-based, modeled after the seminar format. Students will write 2 shorter critical essays and one longer seminar paper.

3320	IDIS 369-A		When you hear the word "technology," you may think of your computer or iPhone. You probably don't think of the alphabet, the book, or the printing press: but each of these inventions was a technological innovation that changed dramatically how we communicate and perhaps even how we think. Texts are at the heart of most disciplines in the humanities: literature, philosophy, history, religious studies?but this course will argue that technology and humanistic study are deeply intertwined. Our primary objective in this course will be to develop ideas about the ways that modern innovations, including computers and the internet, continue to shape our understanding of texts (both classic and contemporary) and the human beings that write, read, and interpret them. In order to help us understand these recent changes, we will compare our own historical moment with previous periods of textual and technological upheavals in Western Culture. We'll learn that many of the debates that seem unique to the twenty-first century?over privacy, intellectual property, and textual authority?are but new iterations of familiar battles in the tumultuous history of technology and literature. We will see how modern scholars are illuminating these debates in our textual past using the rapidly changing tools of our textual present: e.g. geographic information systems, data mining, textual analysis. Finally, we will gain new skills for working with texts as we develop digital projects using texts from the Center for Norbertine Studies' special collections library.
3344	LIST 502-A	Intellectual History: European Enlightenment Luther to French Rev	This course will trace the rise of modern natural science within the context of religious controversy, social upheaval and political transformation across Europe. The century of Enlightenment dates, for the purposes of this course, from the publication of Isaac Newton's Principia Mathematica in 1687, but requires for historical context some treatment of the Reformation of the 16th Century and the early confrontation between science and religion in the early 17th Century. 3584	PEAC 389-A	Special Topics: War	This interdisciplinary course engages the Western cultural tradition and its relationship to other cultural traditions through the human experience of war, using literature and film as well as historical sources. We will study and discuss the experience of combatants and related non-combatants in the Trojan War, the apocalyptic battle described in the biblical Revelation to John (Armageddon), the American Civil War, the 19th century Chechen conflict with Russia, World War I, and the Vietnam "conflict". Participants will do independent research on historical accounts and analyses of each war, which we will put in conversation with the literary texts and films.
3462	PHIL 389-A	Special Topics: Philosophy of Mind	What is a mind? How does it relate to a person's brain? Could a robot or a computer be conscious? How does the mental fit into the physical universe? This course will examine the most important historical and contemporary answers offered to these questions. Specifically, the course will explore theories like dualism, eliminativism, brain-state identity theory, functionalism, and others. Upon completion, each student will be able to articulate the basic issues examined, describe several possible responses to those issues, and to evaluate those positions critically.
3483	PSYC 289-A	Special Topics: Adult Development + Aging	This developmental science course focuses on change and stability in the later part of the lifespan. Some topics to be covered include brain development, biological aging, stress and health, gains and losses in cognitive functioning, and parenting practices and beliefs. Research findings will be discussed in terms of broader cultural context, stereotypes, and social policy implications.
3524	SOCI 289-A	Special Topics: Social Movements	This course investigates the people who have mobilized to change the shape of their society, often at great personal risk. We will consider what has motivated these activists and what has sustained them through hard times and difficult odds. We will look at their successes, as well as mistakes made along the way. We will examine how the contours of our society today are different as a result of their activism. This course traces the development of major movements of the 20th and 21st centuries, including labor, civil rights/Black Power, student, feminist, gay/queer activism, and environmental/human rights struggles by indigenous peoples. We will look at what set these movements into motion, structured their form, and affected what they have achieved. We will investigate the role of resources, strategy, culture and biography in protest.
3533	SOCI 489-A	Special Topics: Childhood + Children in American Society	Students in this course will study: (1) continuity and change in ideas about children and childhood over the course of U.S. history; (2) classic and current sociological theory about childhood and children; (3) research methods for studying children; and (4) empirical studies of children's lives, past and present.
3545	SPAN 389-A	Special Topics: Challenging Authority in Early Modern Spain	This course uses literary masterpieces of the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries to examine how various subjects, such as women, practitioners of love magic, and religious minorities, challenged patriarchal control and the fragile image of Catholic hegemony in early modern Spain. Readings will encompass a variety of genres (novel, short story, drama), include works by male and female writers, and will be informed by critical and theoretical studies of the period.
