New and Special Topics Courses

2003	BIOL 489-A	Special Topics: Neuroscience	A comprehensive lecture, laboratory, and discussion course of the scientific study of the nervous system. Topics covered include the origins of neuroscience, methods of study, neural development, neurophysiology, motor systems, brain sexual differentiation, circadian rhythms, stress, learning and memory, consciousness, and nervous system disorders. Laboratory exercises will focus on histological techniques, neuroanatomy, tract tracing, invertebrate neurophysiology, human electroencephalography, learned sensory responses, and neuroethology. Research articles seminal to the field of neuroscience will also be discussed.
2030	BUAD 273-A		<p>This course is devoted to three core elements of understanding social media in marketing. 1) Discussing the background material and the science behind viral and network marketing. 2) Discovering and exploring social media marketing tools such as blogs, Facebook, Twitter and other state-of-the-art technology. 3) Developing and presenting a project in which students apply the material learned by creating a live social-media enabled marketing initiative.</p> <p>This course is of an interdisciplinary nature. It deals with the development and implementation of campaigns to spread messages of various kinds by using networks. Such attempts are known as viral marketing, social media marketing or network marketing and are used both for commercial purposes (new product introduction, sales promotion) and non-profit purposes (fundraising campaigns, political mobilization, public relations for ideas).</p>
2006	BUAD 289-A	Special Topics: New Venture Creation	New Venture Creation focuses on one of the primary aspects of entrepreneurship, the process of taking a new business from its initial conception to crafting a master plan for implementing the steps necessary to launch the enterprise. Students will have the opportunity to evaluate their own potential as entrepreneurs and to develop a comprehensive planning document that could serve as the platform for ultimately creating a new venture. Much of the course will be conducted online, via the Moodle learning system; students will meet with the instructor for a pre-planning session in early December and will also meet for formal Business Plan presentations at the end of the term.
2029	WMGS 389-A	Special Topics: Medieval Women Mystics + Theologians	This course considers the roles and influence, immediate and enduring, of European women mystics and theologians in the 12th through the 14th century. It focuses on representative women of medieval Europe's religious communities and the beguines of that period who lived outside community. The course draws on religious, theological, literary, and historical sources and methods, as well as women and gender studies, to engage questions about the significance of gender, both in terms of the theologian or mystic as subject and in terms of the gendered content of their work. Some of the class meetings in week two will be held at the Norbertine Center for Spirituality; the instructor will work with students to arrange transportation on those days.
