Works may include Oliver Twist (1838), David Copperfield (1850), Bleak House (1853), Hard Times (1854), Great Expectations (1861), and The Mystery of Edwin Drood (1870). We will read one of the novels in serial form, mirroring the publication history of Dickens?s novels, and watch major film adaptations of select novels.
