## Accommodation and meals

We will be staying at the Medina Classic Canberra in the stylish Kingston area. Each apartment includes two twin-share rooms, bathroom, lounge area and small kitchen.

From the Medina it is a short walk to the Kingston shops and pub; or to the trendy cafes and bars of Manuka. All breakfasts, lunches and dinners will be provided, except on the final day when delegates will be required to purchase their own lunch.

## Cost and inclusions

The participation fee of AUS\$550 includes coach transport to and from Canberra; twin share accommodation; breakfast supplies, 3 lunches, 3 dinners; all program activities including seminars, visits and sightseeing as per the itinerary.
