
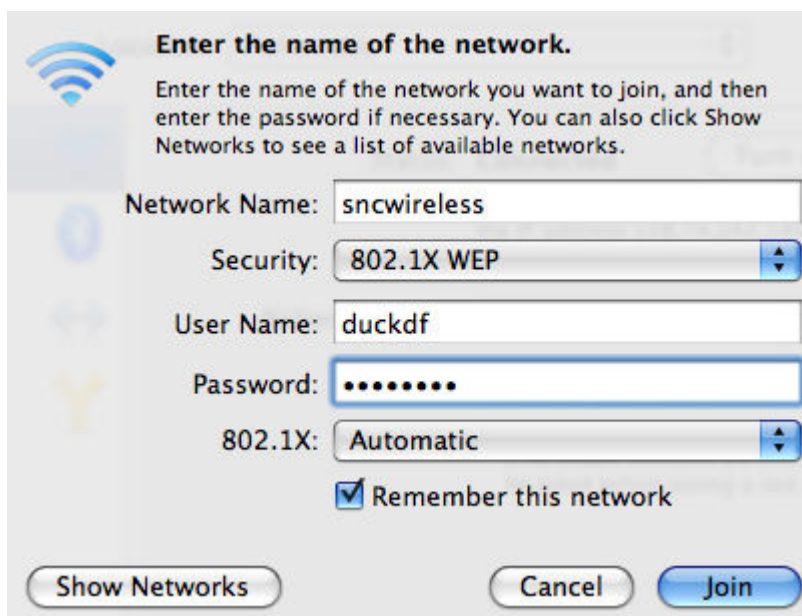
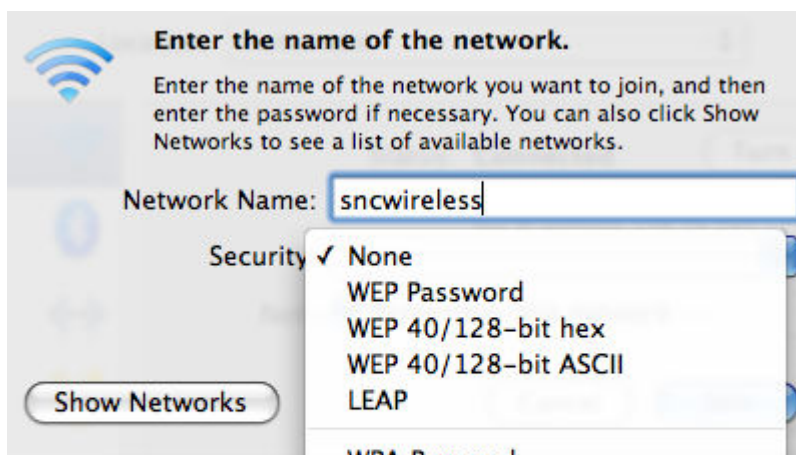


# Setting up a Secure SNC Wireless Connection Macintosh OS 10.5

To configure the secure sncwireless network:

1. Click on the wireless icon  in the upper right and choose Join Other Network.
2. In the Network Name box, type: **sncwireless**
3. From the Security drop-down menu, choose 802.1X WEP (see picture at right).
4. You will then be prompted to log in. In the User Name and Password boxes, type your 6-character SNC network login ID and password, as shown in the second picture.
5. Check the “Remember this network” box.
6. Click Join. Wait while the computer connects to the network.
7. You will probably see an 802.1X Authentication pop-up (shown below) asking you to verify a certificate. Click Continue. You may see this pop-up box more than once, and it may appear again after your computer goes to sleep and wakes up. Just keep clicking Continue.

**Note:** Once connected to the sncwireless network, do not switch to the sncexternal network or you will lose all of your sncwireless configuration and will have to set it up all over again. Allow your computer to detect which network is available and connect automatically. There should be no need to switch from the sncwireless network to the sncexternal network, as there is nothing you can do on sncexternal that you cannot do on sncwireless.
