St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview
St. Norbert College (6-5, 2-2 MWC) at Carroll College (6-3, 2-1 MWC)
Tuesday, January 15, 2008 - 7:30 p.m.
Van Male Fieldhouse (1,200) - Waukesha, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert tries to push its winning streak to five games when it travels to Waukesha to face Carroll. St. Norbert has won five of its last six games, while Carroll has won six of its last seven.

The Series:

Carroll leads St. Norbert 40-32 in a series begun in the 1933-34 season. The Pioneers have won seven straight games in the series since a 79-67 St. Norbert win in Waukesha on Dec. 6, 2003.

Last Meeting:

Carroll beat St. Norbert 77-70 last Feb. 10 in Waukesha. Carroll led 37-33 at halftime and never led by more than eight points in the second half. Nathan Drury led Carroll with 27 points, while Tony Jandron pumped in 20 points for the Green Knights.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 15-18 in his second season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 66-49.

Carroll coach David Schultz (UW-Oshkosh, 1986) is 84-50 in his sixth season in Waukesha.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert pushed its winning streak to four with a 72-47 win over Beloit this past Saturday at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights are 6-5 overall and 2-2 in the Midwest Conference.

The Green Knights are led in scoring by sophomore guard Tony Jandron, who is averaging 10.5 points per game. Senior forward Eric Bieniasz is netting 10.2 points per game while shooting 57.6 percent from the floor. Junior center Tom Katzfey is scoring 9.3 points per game while shooting 61.6 percent from the floor. Seven St. Norbert players are averaging at least 5.0 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring 68.9 points per game while shooting 43.8 percent from the floor, 36.4 percent on 3-pointers and 71.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 61.5 points per game while shooting 39.6 per-- MORE -

cent from the floor, 32.2 percent on 3-pointers and 68.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters Tuesday's game with a 6-3 overall record and a 2-1 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers have been idle since Dec. 29, when they beat Clark 85-82 at the Phoenix Cactus Jam. Carroll's three losses have come to UW-Stevens Point, UW-Whitewater and Grinnell.

Wes Ladwig leads the Pioneers in scoring at 22.7 points per game, and has made 50.8 percent of his shots. Ryan Mueller nets 14.0 points per game and has connected on 47.7 percent of his 3-pointers. John Hoch averages 13.3 points per game and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3to-1

Carroll is averaging 77.4 points per game while shooting 45.7 percent from the floor, 38.4 percent on 3-pointers and 75.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 80.9 points per game while shooting 45.3 percent from the floor, 37.4 percent on 3-pointers and 62.0 percent at the free-throw line.

Turnover Talk:

St. Norbert continues to do a solid job of taking care of the basketball.

St. Norbert has just 129 turnovers in 11 games. When one takes away the 39 turnovers against up-tempo Grinnell on Nov. 30, the Green Knights are averaging just 9.0 turnovers per game. That number would lead Division III. Even with the Grinnell game, St. Norbert is 13th in Division III in fewest turnovers per game.

The Green Knights have had games of single-digit turnovers this season, including just eight against Beloit on Jan. 12.

The Green Knights committed just five turnovers in the overtime win over Division II Northern Michigan on Dec. 17, with the fifth coming with 0.6 seconds left on a shot clock violation while running the clock out.

St. Norbert had not had a game when it committed five turnovers

or less since committing five on Jan. 29, 1997 against Lake Forest, a stretch of 244 games. The Green Knights last had fewer than five when they had only three against Trinity International on Dec. 7,

3 For Me:

In its last five games, St. Norbert opponents are shooting just 15-for-81 (18.5 percent) from beyond the three-point arc. In the same stretch, St. Norbert is 44-for-102 (43.1 percent).

St. Norbert is 4-1 over the fourgame stretch where it has shot well and defended well from the perimeter. The Green Knights' lone setback was a 77-70 double overtime loss to Augustana, which is No. 5 in the most recent D3hoops.com poll.

During St. Norbert's 2-4 start, St. Norbert was 38-for-125 on 3-pointers, just 30.4 percent.

Jump Shots:

- * St. Norbert has outrebounded its last three opponents after being outrebounded in its previous four games. The Green Knights had a plus-9 advantage against Beloit.
- * Eric Gruenewald shared the team scoring lead against Beloit with Tom Katzfey when he scored 12 points. Gruenewald canned four 3-pointers in the second half. Gruenewald became the sixth different St. Norbert player to lead the Green Knights in scoring. Including ties for the lead, Katzfey, Tony Jandron, Eric Bieniasz and Dave Wipperfurth have each led the team in scoring three times. Bryan Fleischmann shared the team scoring lead with Katzfey against
- * St. Norbert's four-game winning streak is its longest since winning four in a row in the middle of last season. The Green Knights have not won five games in a row since reeling off a school-record 16straight victories during the 2001-02 season.
