St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview
No. 19 Lawrence University (13-1, 8-0) at St. Norbert College (10-6, 6-3)
Wednesday, January 30, 2008 - 7:30 p.m.
Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert hosts Lawrence in a matchup of the top two teams in the Midwest Conference standings. The Green Knights also open a four-game homestand with the contest.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lawrence 43-35 in a series begun in the 1917-18 season. Lawrence has won the last five games in the series since an 84-76 St. Norbert win at Alexander Gym over the then 10th-ranked Vikings on Jan. 11, 2005.

Last Meeting:

Lawrence beat St. Norbert 71-57 last Feb. 14 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Vikings led 23-21 at halftime before breaking the game open in the second half. Ryan Kroeger had 28 points for Lawrence, while Tony Jandron had 22 points for St. Norbert.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 19-19 in his second season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 70-50.

Lawrence coach Joel DePagter (Lawrence, 1998) is 13-1 in his first season in Appleton.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters tonight's game with a 10-6 overall record and a 6-3 showing in the Midwest Conference, currently good for second place. The Green Knights have won six straight home games and eight of their last nine overall. St. Norbert swept a pair of road games this past weekend, beating Monmouth 73-58 in overtime and Illinois College 67-62.

Senior forward Eric Bieniasz leads St. Norbert in scoring and rebound-- MORE -

ing, averaging 10.5 points and 4.9 rebounds per game. Bieniasz is 17th in the Midwest Conference in scoring and 14th in rebounding. Junior center Tom Katzfey is second in the Midwest Conference in field goal percentage at 60.6 percent while scoring 9.6 points per game. Sophomore guard Tony Jandron is scoring 9.4 points per game, while junior guard Mike Dowden is shooting 46.6 percent on 3-pointers while netting 8.9 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring 67.8 points per game while shooting 43.8 percent from the floor, 37.0 percent on 3-pointers and 73.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring a league-low 61.2 points per game against St. Norbert while shooting 41.4 percent from the floor, 31.8 percent on 3-pointers and 68.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence, ranked 19th by D3hoops.com, enters tonight's game with a 13-1 record and a firstplace standing of 8-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings have won nine consecutive games since a 75-56 loss at UW-Stevens Point on Dec. 8. Lawrence swept a pair of road games last weekend, beating Illinois College 84-77 and Grinnell 109-106.

Sharpshooting junior guard Ryan Kroeger paces the Vikings. Kroeger is shooting a robust 56.7 percent from the floor and 53.3 percent from beyond the three-point line while scoring 17.3 points per game. Senior forward Andy Hurley leads Lawrence down low with 12.1 points and 7.9 rebounds per game. Sophomore forward John Dekker comes off the bench to score 9.8 points per game. Junior forward Chris Page, who scored a schoolrecord 48 points against Grinnell on Saturday, is averaging 9.6 points and 6.1 rebounds per game.

Lawrence is scoring 80.9 points per game while shooting 50.7 percent from the floor, 43.1 percent on 3-pointers and 70.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 68.1 points per game while shooting 39.5 percent from the field,

31.7 percent on 3-pointers and 73.7 percent at the free-throw line.

Overtime Observations:

St. Norbert improved to 2-2 this season in overtime games when it beat Monmouth 73-58 this past Friday on the road.

This season the Green Knights have dropped a tough 58-52 decision at Dominican on Nov. 17, then lost a 77-70 double overtime heartbreaker to No. 10 Augustana on Dec. 8 at Schuldes Sports Center, and beat Northern Michigan at home in its next game 59-50 on Dec. 17.

St. Norbert had not played backto-back overtime games since beating Beloit 66-55 on Jan. 24, 1995 and topping Carroll 79-68 three days later.

The Green Knights have not played four overtime games in a season since 1994-95, when they went 2-2 in overtime contests.

St. Norbert has never played five overtime games in a season.

Jump Shots:

- * In its last eight games, St. Norbert is 103-for-129 at the freethrow line, good for 79.8 percent.
- * In his last seven games, junior guard Mike Dowden is 23-for-40 on 3-pointers, good for a blistering-hot 57.5 percent.
- * St. Norbert is leading the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 61.2 points per game. Without the Grinnell game, the Green Knights are allowing 58.6 points per game. St. Norbert's 61.4 points allowed per game is 18th in Division III.
- * St. Norbert is ninth in Division III in fewest turnovers per game at 11.1. Without the 39 turnovers against Grinnell, St. Norbert is averaging just 9.0 turnovers per game which would be tops in Division III.
- * -St. Norbert had a season-low 10 fouls whistled against it this past Saturday at Illinois College.
- * St. Norbert is second in the Midwest Conference in turnover margin at plus-2.81 per game. St. Norbert is third in assist-toturnover ratio at +-1.07 per game.
