# St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview Ripon College (8-9, 3-7) at St. Norbert College (10-7, 6-4) Tuesday, February 5, 2008 - 8 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

# **Game Overview:**

St. Norbert looks to remain in the hunt for a spot in the Midwest Conference Tournament when it hosts longtime rival Ripon at Schuldes Sports Center.

# The Series:

Ripon holds a 58-38 series lead over St. Norbert in a hotly contested rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The two teams have split the last four meetings in De Pere, with Ripon winning 68-65 here last season. St. Norbert won this season's earlier meeting by a 61-59 score on Dec. 5 in Ripon.

# Last Meeting:

St. Norbert rallied to beat Ripon 61-59 on Dec. 5 at the Storzer Center in Ripon. The Green Knights overcame an early 13-2 deficit, and got 3-pointers from Dave Wipperfurth and Eric Bieniasz in the game's final moments to seal the win. Wipperfurth had 12 points and Bieniasz 10 for St. Norbert, while Scott Gillespie led Ripon with 22 points.

# The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 19-20 in his second season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 70-51.

Ripon coach Bob Gillespie (Lewis, 1971) is 453-206 in his 28th season in Ripon.

# About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters Tuesday's game against Ripon with a 10-7 overall record and a 6-4 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights have been idle since this past Wednesday, when they lost at home 65-56 to No. 19 Lawrence. St. Norbert has won eight of its last 10 games and nine of its last 12 since a 1-4 start.

Senior forward Eric Bieniasz is the lone St. Norbert player scoring double figures, averaging 10.1 points per game. Three other players are scoring at least nine points per game however, with junior center Tom Katzfey averaging 9.8 points per game. Sophomore guard Tony Jandron is scoring 9.5 points per game, while junior guard Mike Dowden is scoring 9.1 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring 67.1 points per game while shooting 43.5 percent from the floor, 36.7 percent on 3-pointers and 73.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring a league-low 61.4 points per game against St. Norbert while shooting 41.8 percent from the floor, 32.0 percent on 3-pointers and 69.5 percent at the free-throw line.

### **About the Red Hawks:**

Ripon enters Tuesday's game with an 8-9 overall record and a 3-7 record in Midwest Conference action. The Red Hawks have won three of their last seven games and have won seven of 11 since a 1-5 start. Ripon beat Beloit 91-69 this past Saturday in its most recent game.

The Red Hawks are led in scoring by freshman guard Scott Gillespie. Gillespie, the son of head coach Bob Gillespie, led Wisconsin high school players in scoring last year and is netting 20.5 points per game this season. Senior forward Chris Kellett is averaging 15.2 points per game, while senior forward Paul Wise is scoring 8.8 points per game. Senior forward Tyler Fischer is grabbing a team-high 6.5 rebounds per game.

Ripon is averaging 78.7 points per game while shooting 46.8 percent from the floor, 35.2 percent on 3pointers and 69.0 percent from the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 78.0 points per game while shooting 43.4 percent from the floor, 35.2 percent on 3-pointers and 69.2 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **Home Sweet Home:**

St. Norbert is playing 13 games this season within the friendly confines of Schuldes Sports Center.

The Green Knights are 6-3 at home this season, with losses coming to UW-Oshkosh (78-68), Augustana (77-70, 2 ot) and Lawrence (65-56). All three of those teams have been nationally ranked by D3hoops.com this season.

St. Norbert has beaten NCAA Division II Northern Michigan, Rockford, St. John's, Beloit, Illinois College and Lake Forest on its home floor this season.

St. Norbert has not played 13 home games in a season since the 1988-89 season. The Green Knights were 7-6 at home that season en route to a 12-10 campaign.

## Jump Shots:

\* - In its last nine games, St. Norbert is 112-for-140 at the freethrow line, good for an even 80 percent. The Green Knights are now second in the Midwest Conference in free-throw percentage at 73.3 percent.

\* - In his last seven games, junior guard Mike Dowden is 26-for-47 on 3-pointers, good for a blistering-hot 55.3 percent.

\* - St. Norbert is leading the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 61.4 points per game. Without the Grinnell game, the Green Knights are allowing 59.0 points per game. St. Norbert's 61.4 points allowed per game is 18th in Division III.

\* - St. Norbert has led at halftime in nine of its last 11 games. The Green Knights are 9-2 in those games. St. Norbert rallied from a 30-23 halftime deficit to win at Illinois College on Jan. 26. The Green Knights lost a 30-24 halftime lead to Lawrence on Jan. 30.

\* - St. Norbert has not shot over 50 percent from the floor in a game since shooting 50.9 percent (28-for-55) against Beloit on Jan. 12.

\* - St. Norbert was 5-for-16 on 3pointers against Lawrence, its lowest output from beyond the arc since going 5-for-20 against Northern Michigan on Dec. 17.

\* - St. Norbert has outrebounded six of its last nine opponents.
