St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview MIDWEST CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT Fri., Feb. 29 - St. Norbert College (14-9) at No. 16 Lawrence Univ. (20-2) - 7 p.m. Sat., Mar. 1 - Championship vs. Grinnell (16-7) or Carroll (14-8) - 3 p.m. Alexander Gym (850) - Appleton, Wisconsin

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert is two wins away from returning to the NCAA Division III Tournament for the first time since 2002. The Green Knights are making just their fourth Midwest Conference Tournament appearance since the tournament expanded to four teams in 1991.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lawrence 43-37 in a series begun in the 1917-18 season. Lawrence has won the last six games in the series since an 84-76 St. Norbert win at Alexander Gym over the then 10th-ranked Vikings on Jan. 11, 2005.

Carroll leads St. Norbert 41-33 in a series begun in the 1933-34 season. The Pioneers hade won eight straight games in the series before St. Norbert posted a 69-59 win in De Pere on Feb. 16.

St. Norbert leads Grinnell 17-11 in a series begun in 1983-84. The two teams have split their last eight meetings.

This Year:

St. Norbert is 2-4 against this year's tournament field. The Green Knights were 0-2 against Lawrence losing 65-56 on Jan. 30 in De Pere and 69-61 on Feb. 20 in Appleton. St. Norbert split with Carroll, losing 71-55 on Jan. 15 in Waukesha and winning 69-59 on Feb. 16 in De Pere. The Green Knights also split with Grinnell, losing 100-87 on Nov. 30 in Grinnell, Iowa, and winning 123-106 on Feb. 9 in De Pere.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 23-22 in his second season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 74-53.

Lawrence coach Joel DePagter (Lawrence, 1998) is 20-2 in his first season in Appleton.

Carroll coach David Schultz (UW-Oshkosh, 1986) is 92-55 in his sixth season in Waukesha.

Grinnell coach David Arseneault (Colby, 1976) is 232-200 in his 19th year in Grinnell.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the tournament with a 14-9 overall record and tied for third with a 10-6 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights have been idle since a 69-61 loss to Lawrence on Feb. 20. Since a 2-5 start, the Green Knights are 12-4.

Senior forward Eric Bieniasz leads the Green Knights in scoring at 11.5 points per game while shooting 57.3 percent from the floor while grabbing 4.7 rebounds per game. Junior center Tom Katzfey is averaging 10.4 points and 4.9 rebounds per game. Junior guard Mike Dowden is averaging 9.4 points per game and has scored in double figures in nine of his last 11 games.

St. Norbert is scoring 69.6 points per game while shooting 44.9 percent from the floor, 37.6 percent on 3-pointers and 75.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 64.3 points per game against St. Norbert while shooting 42.6 percent from the floor, 34.6 percent on 3-pointers and 69.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the tournament ranked 16th in the D3hoops.com Top 25, and is 20-2 overall. The Vikings won their fourth Midwest Conference championship in the last five years with a 15-1 record.

Junior guard Ryan Kroeger leads the Vikings in scoring at 17.1 points per game and is shooting 56.3 percent from the floor. Senior forward Andy Hurley is scoring 12.1 points with 8.2 rebounds per game, while junior center Chris Page is scoring 11.2 points per game while shooting a league-high 64.5 percent from the floor.

Lawrence is scoring 82.7 points per game while shooting 50.6 percent from the floor, 41.9 percent on 3-pointers and 72.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 69.7 points per game while shooting 40.0 percent from the floor, 32.3 percent on 3-pointers and 73.8 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Pioneers I:

Carroll enters the tournament at 14-8 overall, and has lost its last three games.

Junior guard Wes Ladwig is scoring 22.7 points per game, while sophomore guard John Hoch is adding 15.1 points per game. Senior forward Ryan mueller is averaging 13.7 points and 5.6 rebounds per game.

Carroll is averaging 82.3 percent from the floor while shooting 49.6 percent. Defensively, Carroll is allowing 78.5 points per game.

About the Pioneers II:

Grinnell enters the tournament 16-7 and placed second in the Midwest Conference at 11-5.

Junior guard John Grotberg is second in the nation in scoring at 27.8 points per game. Junior guard Bobby Long is netting 21.8 points per game, while junior guard David Arseneualt is averaging 16.6 points and 10.4 assists per game.

Grinnell is leading Division III in scoring at 107.3 points per game. The Pioneers are allowing 100.1 points per game with opponents shooting 62.5 percent from the floor.

Straight A's:

Senior forward Eric Bieniasz has been named a first-team College Division Academic All-All American as selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) and ESPN The Magazine.

Bieniasz, a Germantown native and a graduate of Germantown High School, holds a perfect 4.00 grade point average with a major in business administration.

Bieniasz is just one of five players named to the College Division first team, which is selected from student-athletes at NCAA Division II, Division III and NAIA schools.

A two-year team captain, Bieniasz was an Academic All-Midwest Conference selection in

2006 and 2007. He is also a member of the St. Norbert Student Athlete Advisory Committee and is a Student Alumni Ambassador. Bieniasz also assists with the on-campus Special Olympics Day and aids with research in the college's Study Abroad Department.

Tourney Talk:

St. Norbert is in the midst of its 25th season of playing basketball in the Midwest Conference, and has now qualified for league post-season play for the fifth time.

The Green Knights will play in the four-team event on Feb. 29-March 1 at Alexander Gym in Appleton, their first MWC Tournament appearance since hosting in 2002. St. Norbert also played in league post-season action in 1984, 1994 and 1999.

St. Norbert has made two NCAA Division III Tournament appearances - in 1984 and 2002.

A March to March:

Should St. Norbert beat Lawrence in

the Midwest Conference Tournament on Feb. 29, the Green Knights would earn their first game played in the month of March in 24 years.

The Green Knights have played only three men's basketball games in March since 1968.

St. Norbert most recently played in March when it played two games in the 1984 NCAA Division III Tournament at UW-Whitewater. The Green Knights fell 87-84 in triple overtime to eventual national champion UW-Whitewater on March 3, 1984 in the regional title game. St. Norbert beat North Central 69-56 the previous day.

The Green Knights also played on March 3, 1980 in a NAIA District 14 Playoff semifinal game, when they lost at UW-Eau Claire 67-42.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert's 14-win season marks just the fourth time the Green Knights have won that many games in a season in 21 years. The Green Knights won 21 games in 2002, 17 games in 1999 and 14 games in 1994. * - St. Norbert leads the Midwest Conference in free-throw shooting at 75.8 percent. In their last 10 games, the Green Knights are 145-for-176 (82.4 percent) at the free-throw line. The Green Knights are 14th nationally in free-throw shooting in this week's NCAA Division III statistical rankings. * - St. Norbert has lost 10 straight games to teams ranked in the D3hoops.com Top 25. The Green Knights last win over a ranked opponent came when they beat No. 10 Lawrence 84-76 in Appleton on Jan. 11, 2005.

* - St. Norbert's scoring defense of 64.3 points per game leads the Midwest Conference and is 45th in Division III. Excluding the two Grinnell games, the Green Knights' scoring defense is 60.7 points per game, which would be 11th nationally. * - St. Norbert is 4-4 on the road this season, and has won four of its last six games away from Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights were 9-4 on their home floor this season.
