St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 12 St. Norbert College (14-1, 8-0 MWC) vs. Carroll Univ. (11-5, 6-3 MWC) Wednesday, January 27, 2010 - 5 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert faces another tough challenge in the Midwest Conference race when it hosts second-place Carroll at Schuldes Sports Center.

The Series:

Carroll leads St. Norbert 42-34 in a series begun in the 1933-34 season. The Green Knights have won two of the last three meetings, and the two schools won on each other's court last season.

Last Meeting:

Carroll beat St. Norbert 64-51 last Feb. 21 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere, a loss that kept the Green Knights from a share of the Midwest Conference championship. John Hoch and Kyle Jones each had 18 points for Carroll, while John Taylor had 14 points for St. Norbert.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 53-30 in his fourth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 104-61.

Carroll coach Dave Buchanan (UW-La Crosse, 1995) is 11-5 in his first season in Waukesha. He was 30-47 in three seasons at UW-Superior to give him a career record of 41-52.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, which has won 44 of its last 56 games, enters the game with a 14-1 overall record and an 8-0 record in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights swept a pair of crucial road games last weekend, topping Illinois College 74-68 in overtime on Friday and Knox 56-45 on Saturday.

Junior guard Dave Wipperfurth, who missed the weekend's two games due to injury, is the team's leading scorer at 14.7 points per game. Junior center Chris Peterson, who netted a career-high 32 points in the win over Illinois College, is now averaging 12.9 points per game and is shooting 54 percent from the floor. Junior guard John Taylor is scoring 9.6 points per game with 4.4 assists per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 73.3 points per game, and is shooting 46.7 percent from the floor, 36.4 percent on 3-pointers and 76.3 percent at - MORE -

Wis. Note: Home games in bold; (rankings) by D3hoops.com. All times Central Standard Time. the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 59.1 points per game while shooting 38.0 percent from the floor, 26.0 percent on 3-pointers and 71.5 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the game with an 11-5 mark overall and a 6-3 showing in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers split a pair of league road games last weekend, topping Knox 77-70 on Friday before losing at the final buzzer to Grinnell 101-99 on Saturday.

Senior guard John Hoch leads the Midwest Conference in scoring at 24.2 points per game and is also averaging 6.6 assists per game. Hoch is shooting 49.1 percent from the floor, 45.8 percent on 3-pointers and 86.5 percent at the free-throw line. Junior forward Paul Grosshuesch is averaging 12.3 points and 9.8 rebounds per game, while senior guard Eric Thompson is averaging 11.6 points per game.

Carroll is averaging 79.1 points per game while shooting 46.5 percent from the floor, 36.1 percent on 3-pointers and 71.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 74.8 points per game while shooting 44.1 percent from the floor, 32.9 percent on 3-pointers and 68.1 percent at the free-throw line.

Run and Gun:

Despite not having an individual scorer in the top 12 in the MWC, St. Norbert has gone over the 100-point total in a game twice this season - in a 112-73 win over Silver Lake on Nov. 15 and in a 109-72 win over Grinnell on Jan. 16.

Going over 100 points against Grinnell is nothing new, but nearly the last 10 minutes of the game was played in the half-court. St. Norbert went over the century mark with 9 minutes 51 seconds left in the game.

The 100-point games against two different opponents marks the first time in 34 years the Green Knights have topped that plateau against two different foes in the same year.

The Green Knights hit the 100-point mark five times in 1975-76,

reaching it against Northland, Carroll, Silver Lake (twice) and Mount Senario.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert held its third opponent of the 2009-10 season under 50 points with a 56-45 win over Knox on Jan. 23.

The Green Knights lead the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 59.1 points per game, which is good for eighth in the national NCAA Division III statistical rankings. In conference play, St. Norbert is allowing a mere 55.8 points per game.

In Gary Grzesk's 85-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 12 times, going 12-0 in those games. It happened twice in 2006-07, four times in 2007-08, three times in 2008-09 and three times this year.

Building a Winner:

In just three years, head coach Gary Grzesk has revived the St. Norbert men's basketball program. The Green Knights doubled their win total in two years, going from nine wins in 2006-07 to 18 in 2008-09.

St. Norbert's 18 wins last season marked just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights have won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and 19 once (1951).

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 44-12. The Green Knights were ranked as high as No. 11 in the D3hoops.com Top 25 during the 2008-09 season, the highest mark in program history. St. Norbert has been ranked as high as No. 12 three different times during the 2009-10 season.

St. Norbert's 14 wins this season marks just the third time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 14 games in three consecutive seasons. A five-year stretch from 1983-87 is the first occasion. The Green Knights have never won 15 games in three consecutive seasons.
