St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview
No. 12 St. Norbert College (15-1, 9-0 MWC) at Beloit College (5-11, 3-6 MWC)
Saturday, January 30, 2010 - 2 p.m.
Flood Arena (2,250) - Beloit, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert looks to maintain its three-game lead with seven games left in the Midwest Conference race when it travels to the State Line Area to face Beloit.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Beloit 33-20 in a series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights have won 23 of the last 28 meetings.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert beat Beloit 73-46 on Jan. 4 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Green Knights jumped out to a 35-15 halftime lead and went on from there. Dave Wipperfurth led St. Norbert with 13 points, and Mike Brumm added 12. David Bremner and Travis Towns each had nine points for Beloit.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 56-30 in his fourth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 107-61.

Beloit coach Brian Vraney (Wisconsin, 1998) is 13-49 in his third season in Beloit.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, which has won 45 of its last 57 games, enters the game with a 15-1 overall record and a 9-0 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights kept their three-game lead in the Midwest Conference standings with a 76-58 win over Carroll on Wednesday.

Junior guard Dave Wipperfurth is the team's leading scorer at 14.6 points per game. Junior center Chris Peterson is averaging 12.8 points per game while shooting 54.2 percent from the floor, and is averaging a team-high 5.8 rebounds per game. Junior guard John Taylor is scoring 9.5 points per game with 4.6 assists per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 73.5 points per game, and is shooting 47.1 percent from the floor, 35.6 percent on 3-pointers and 76.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 59.0 points per - MORE -

game while shooting 38.1 percent from the floor, 25.8 percent on 3pointers and 76.5 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Buccaneers:

Beloit enters the game with a 5-11 mark overall and a 3-6 ledger in Midwest Conference actions. The Buccaneers have been idle since last weekend, losing 67-62 Monmouth on Friday before rebounding to top Lake Forest 62-45 on Saturday.

Sophomore guard Travis Towns leads Beloit at 14.8 points per game. Sophomore forward David Bremner is netting 13.8 points per game while grabbing 5.9 rebounds per game. Sophomore forward Derek Carrier is averaging 8.6 points per game while shooting a team-best 48.2 percent from the floor.

Beloit is averaging 63.1 points per game while shooting 44.3 percent from the floor, 30.0 percent on 3pointers and 66.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 69.8 points per game while shooting 45.2 percent from the floor, 29.1 percent on 3-pointers and 67.4 percent at the free-throw line.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert held its third opponent of the 2009-10 season under 50 points with a 56-45 win over Knox on Jan. 23.

The Green Knights, who held Carroll to 21 points under its season average and Pioneers' guard John Hoch to 17 points under his season average in a 76-58 win on Jan. 27, lead the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 59.0 points per game. Their defensive mark is good for eighth in the national NCAA Division III statistical rankings. In conference play, St. Norbert is allowing a mere 56.0 points per game.

In Gary Grzesk's 86-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 12 times, going 12-0 in those games. It happened twice in 2006-07, four times in 2007-08, three times in 2008-09 and three times this year.

Run and Gun:

Despite not having an individual scorer in the top 12 in the MWC, St. Norbert has gone over the 100-point total in a game twice this season - in a 112-73 win over Silver Lake on Nov. 15 and in a 109-72 win over Grinnell on Jan. 16.

Going over 100 points against Grinnell is nothing new, but nearly the last 10 minutes of the game was played in the half-court. St. Norbert went over the century mark with 9 minutes 51 seconds left in the game.

The 100-point games against two different opponents marks the first time in 34 years the Green Knights have topped that plateau against two different foes in the same year.

The Green Knights hit the 100point mark five times in 1975-76, reaching it against Northland, Carroll, Silver Lake (twice) and Mount Senario.

Building a Winner:

In just three years, head coach Gary Grzesk has revived the St. Norbert men's basketball program. The Green Knights doubled their win total in two years, going from nine wins in 2006-07 to 18 in 2008-

St. Norbert's 18 wins last season marked just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights have won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and 19 once (1951).

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 45-12. The Green Knights were ranked as high as No. 11 in the D3hoops.com Top 25 during the 2008-09 season, the highest mark in program history. St. Norbert has been ranked as high as No. 12 three different times during the 2009-10 season.

St. Norbert's 15 wins this season marks just the third time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 14 games in three consecutive seasons. A five-year stretch from 1983-87 is the first occasion. The Green Knights have never won 15 games in three consecutive seasons.
