St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 9 St. Norbert College (16-1, 10-0 MWC) at Lawrence Univ. (8-9, 5-5 MWC) Tuesday, February 2, 2010 - 5 p.m. Alexander Gym (1,050) - Appleton, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert, which leads the rest of the Midwest Conference by three games in the loss column with six games left to play, tries to snap a 10-game losing streak against Lawrence when it travels to the Fox Valley to face the Vikings.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lawrence 43-40 in an all-time series dating back to the 1917-18, making it one of the Green Knights' two oldest rivalries. The Vikings have claimed the last 10 games in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert beat Lawrence 65-38 last Feb. 14 at Alexander Gym in Appleton. The Green Knights shot just 21.1 percent from the floor in the game, including 4-for-28 in the first half to trail 31-17 at halftime. Dave Wipperfurth led St. Norbert with nine points, while John Dekker paced the Vikings with 17 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 57-30 in his fourth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 108-61.

Lawrence coach Joel DePagter (Lawrence, 1998) is 49-19 in his third season in Appleton.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, which has won 46 of its last 58 games, enters the game with a 16-1 overall record and a 10-0 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights kept their three-game lead in the Midwest Conference standings with a 77-69 overtime win Saturday at Beloit.

Junior guard Dave Wipperfurth is the team's leading scorer at 14.5 points per game. Junior center Chris Peterson is averaging 13.1 points per game while shooting 54.8 percent from the floor, and is averaging a team-high 5.8 rebounds per game. Junior guard John Taylor is scoring 9.9 points per game with 4.6 assists per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 73.7 points per game, and is shooting - MORE -

47.0 percent from the floor, 35.3 percent on 3-pointers and 76.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 59.6 points per game while shooting 38.9 percent from the floor, 27.4 percent on 3-pointers and 71.4 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the game with an 8-9 overall record and a 5-5 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings have lost four of their last six games, but topped Carroll 84-75 at home this past Saturday.

Senior forward John Dekker leads Lawrence at 22.4 points per game, and has made 57 of 130 three-point field-goal attempts. Junior center Erik Borresen is averaging 12.8 points and a team-high 7.4 rebounds per game. Senior guard Dustin Lee is netting 12.0 points per game.

Lawrence is averaging 72.1 points per game while shooting 44.3 percent from the floor, 35.0 percent on 3-pointers and 68.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 69.2 points per game while shooting 42.3 percent from the floor, 36.1 percent on 3-pointers and 64.2 percent at the free-throw line.

Taylor Tidbits:

St. Norbert junior guard John Taylor is ranked in the top 10 in a pair of NCAA Division III national statistical categories.

Taylor's 91.2 percent free-throw percentage is fifth nationally, while his 3.16 assist-to-turnover ratio is good for eighth in the country.

In his last 10 games, Taylor has totaled 51 assists against 11 turnovers while manning the point for the Green Knights. Taylor had a career-high nine assists against Ripon on Jan. 9 and had eight against Carroll on Jan. 27.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert held its third opponent of the 2009-10 season under 50 points with a 56-45 win over Knox on Jan. 23.

The Green Knights, who held Carroll to 21 points under its season

average and Pioneers' guard John Hoch to 17 points under his season average in a 76-58 win on Jan. 27, lead the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 59.6 points per game. Their defensive mark is good for eighth in the national NCAA Division III statistical rankings. In conference play, St. Norbert is allowing a mere 57.3 points per game.

In Gary Grzesk's 87-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 12 times, going 12-0 in those games. It happened twice in 2006-07, four times in 2007-08, three times in 2008-09 and three times this year.

Building a Winner:

In just three years, head coach Gary Grzesk has revived the St. Norbert men's basketball program. The Green Knights doubled their win total in two years, going from nine wins in 2006-07 to 18 in 2008-09.

St. Norbert's 18 wins last season marked just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights have won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and 19 once (1951).

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 46-12. The Green Knights were ranked as high as No. 11 in the D3hoops.com Top 25 during the 2008-09 season, the highest mark in program history. St. Norbert has been ranked as high as No. 12 three different times during the 2009-10 season.

St. Norbert's 16 wins this season marks just the second time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 14 games in three consecutive seasons. A five-year stretch from 1983-87 is the first occasion. The Green Knights have never won 15 games in three consecutive seasons.
