### St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview

**No. 9 St. Norbert College (17-1, 11-0 MWC) vs. Monmouth College (5-13, 4-7 MWC)  
 Fri., Feb. 5 - Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wis. - 7 p.m.**  
**No. 9 St. Norbert College (17-1, 11-0 MWC) vs. Lake Forest College (9-9, 7-4 MWC)  
 Sat., Feb. 6 - Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wis. - 4 p.m.**

#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert, which leads the rest of the Midwest Conference by three games in the loss column with five games left to play, faces a pair of key home games against Monmouth and Lake Forest this weekend at Schuldes Sports Center.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lake Forest 31-17 in an all-time series started in the 1983-84 season. St. Norbert has won the last six meetings in the series.

St. Norbert leads Monmouth 17-11 in an all-time series started in the 1983-84 season. St. Norbert is 11-2 at home against Monmouth.

#### Last Meetings:

St. Norbert topped Monmouth 70-58 on Dec. 5 in Monmouth, Ill. John Taylor had 25 points and Dave Wipperfurth added 16 for St. Norbert, while Eric Cogdill had 15 points and 10 rebounds for Monmouth.

St. Norbert beat Lake Forest 69-58 on Dec. 4 in Lake Forest, Ill. Dave Wipperfurth had 19 points and John Taylor 17 for St. Norbert, while Travis Clark had 18 points and 12 rebounds for Lake Forest.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 58-30 in his fourth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 109-61.

Monmouth coach Mark Vershaw (Wisconsin, 2000) is 20-43 in his third season in Monmouth.

Lake Forest coach Chris Conger (Wisconsin, 1995) is 151-169 in his 14th season in Lake Forest.

#### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, which has won 47 of its last 59 games, enters the weekend with a 17-1 overall record and an 11-0 record in the Midwest Conference while being ranked ninth in this week's D3hoops.com Top 25. The Green Knights recorded its largest win at Lawrence in 17 years with a 66-48 win over the Vikings on Tuesday.

Junior guard Dave Wipperfurth paces the Green Knights' scoring column at 14.3 points per game. Junior center Chris Peterson is averaging 13.2 points and a team-high 5.6 rebounds per game, and is shooting 55.5 percent from the floor. Junior guard John Taylor is averaging 9.9 points per game

and is among the NCAA Division III leaders in free-throw shooting (91.8 percent) and assist-to-turnover ratio (3.19)

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 73.3 points per game, and is shooting 47.0 percent from the floor, 35.3 percent on 3-pointers and 75.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 58.9 points per game while shooting 38.6 percent from the floor, 26.6 percent on 3-pointers and 71.7 percent at the charity stripe.

#### About the Scots:

Monmouth enters the game with a 5-13 overall record and a 4-7 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Scots had a modest two-game winning streak snapped in an 80-53 loss at Lake Forest this past Tuesday.

Junior forward Eric Cogdill leads Monmouth in scoring and rebounding at 14.2 points and 7.3 caroms per game while shooting 50.3 percent from the floor. Senior forward Zach Ott is averaging 10.9 points and 4.9 rebounds per game and is shooting 51.1 percent from the floor.

Monmouth is averaging 67.2 points per game while shooting 41.4 percent from the floor, 35.1 percent on 3-pointers and 61.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 78.5 points per game while shooting 46.8 percent from the floor, 36.9 percent on 3-pointers and 68.1 percent at the free-throw line.

#### About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters Friday's game at Carroll as one of the hottest teams in the Midwest Conference. The Foresters entered the game having won seven of their last eight games, including an 80-53 drubbing of Monmouth this past Tuesday.

Sophomore center Travis Clark has enjoyed a strong season to date, averaging 17.1 points and 9.1 rebounds per game while shooting a glittering 66.7 percent from the floor. Senior forward Victor Campbell is averaging 9.6 points per game, while sophomore forward Nate Bateman is netting 9.1 points per game.

Lake Forest is averaging 71.5 points per game while shooting

48.1 percent from the floor, 31.5 percent on 3-pointers and 57.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 68.4 points per game while shooting 39.2 percent from the floor, 34.0 percent on 3-pointers and 68.3 percent at the free-throw line.

#### D is for Defense:

St. Norbert held its fourth opponent of the 2009-10 season under 50 points with a 66-48 win over Lawrence on Feb. 2.

The Green Knights lead the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 58.9 points per game. Their defensive mark is good for eighth in the national NCAA Division III statistical rankings. In conference play, St. Norbert is allowing a mere 56.5 points per game.

In Gary Grzesk's 88-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 13 times, going 13-0 in those games. It happened twice in 2006-07, four times in 2007-08, three times in 2008-09 and four times this year.

#### Building a Winner:

In just three years, head coach Gary Grzesk has revived the St. Norbert men's basketball program. The Green Knights doubled their win total in two years, going from nine wins in 2006-07 to 18 in 2008-09.

St. Norbert's 18 wins last season marked just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights have won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and 19 once (1951).

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 47-12. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 11-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 9 ranking the week of Feb. 1.

St. Norbert's 17 wins this season marks just the second time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 14 games in three consecutive seasons. A five-year stretch from 1983-87 is the first occasion. The Green Knights have never won 15 games in three consecutive seasons.
