St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview MIDWEST CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT Fri., Feb. 26 - No. 17 St. Norbert College (20-3) vs. Ripon (15-8) - 6 p.m. Sat., Feb. 27 - Championship vs. Lake Forest (14-9) or Carroll (15-8) - 3 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

### **Tournament Overview:**

The winner of the Midwest Conference Tournament will receive the league's automatic qualifier into the NCAA Division III Tournament. Friday's game with Ripon will only be St. Norbert's fourth post-season home game since 1961.

### The Series:

Ripon holds a 58-43 series lead over St. Norbert in a hotly contested rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have won the last six meetings. Ripon is 2-0 against St. Norbert all-time in the MWC Tournament, winning in the 1999 and 2002 championship games.

St. Norbert leads Lake Forest 31-18 in an all-time series started in the 1983-84 season. St. Norbert has won the last six of the last seven meetings in the series.

Carroll leads St. Norbert 43-35 in a series begun in the 1933-34 season. The Green Knights have won three of the last four meetings.

### **Last Meetings:**

St. Norbert beat Ripon 77-72 on Feb. 10 in De Pere. Chris Peterson had 21 points and John Taylor 19 points for St. Norbert, while Scott Gillespie had 25 points for the Red Hawks.

Lake Forest beat St. Norbert 66-59 on Feb. 6 in De Pere. Patrick Hanley had 30 points, including six 3-pointers, to lead Lake Forest. Dave Wipperfurth had 26 points for St. Norbert.

Carroll topped St. Norbert 77-68 on Feb. 20 in Waukesha. The Pioneers led 32-20 at halftime and were led by John Hoch's 27 points. John Taylor and Dave Wipperfurth had 15 points each for St. Norbert.

### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 61-32 in his fourth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 112-63.

Ripon coach Bob Gillespie (Lewis, 1971) is 480-230 in his 30th season in Ripon.

Lake Forest coach Chris Conger (Wisconsin, 1995) is 154-169 in his 14th season in Lake Forest.

Carroll coach Dave Buchanan (UW-La Crosse, 1995) is 15-8 in his first season in Waukesha. He was 30-47 in three seasons at UW-Superior to give him a career record of 45-55.

### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the tournament at 20-3 overall after winning the MWC with a 14-2 record.

Junior guard Dave Wipperfurth leads St. Norbert in scoring at 14.2 points per game. Junior center Chris Peterson is averaging 13.4 points and 5.2 rebounds per game. Junior guard John Taylor is totaling 10.5 points and 4.3 assists per game while shooting 90 percent at the free-throw line.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 72.6 points per game, and is shooting 46.3 percent from the floor, 34.8 percent on 3-pointers and 75.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 59.9 points per game while shooting 39.1 percent from the floor, 27.2 percent on 3-pointers and 72.2 percent at the charity stripe.

### About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the tournament 15-8 overall and 10-6 in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks have lost three of their last four games.

Sophomore forward Aris Wurtz leads Ripon in scoring at 22.2 points per game and has a team-high 7.7 rebounds per game. Junior guard Scott Gillespie is averaging 22.0 points per game with 7.3 assists per game. The two players have accounted for 52.6 percent of Ripon's shots and 54.3 percent of the Red Hawks' points.

Ripon is averaging 81.4 points per game while shooting 51.7 percent from the floor, 35.5 percent on 3pointers and 72.9 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 75.1 points per game while shooting 45.0 percent from the floor, 34.4 percent on 3-pointers and 66.8 percent at the free-throw line.

### **About the Foresters:**

Lake Forest enters the tournament as the hottest team in the league, having won 12 of its last 13 games to stand at 14-9 overall and a runner-up 12-4 mark in the MWC.

Sophomore center Travis Clark leads the Foresters at 17.7 points per game while shooting 68.3 percent from the floor. Clark also grabs an average of 9.0 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Nate Bateman is netting an average of 9.2 points per game.

Lake Forest is scoring an average of 72.3 points per game while shooting 48.4 percent from the floor, 33.4 percent on 3-pointers and 60.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 67.1 points per game while shooting 39.4 percent from the floor, 34.6 percent on 3-pointers and 69.1 percent at the free-throw line.

### **About the Pioneers:**

Carroll enters the game at 15-8 overall and 10-6 in the MWC.

Senior guard John Hoch leads the Midwest Conference in scoring at 24.2 points per game, and is also averaging 5.8 assists per game. Hoch is also shooting 45.3 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Junior forward Paul Grosshuesch is scoring 13.3 points per game while shooting 53.1 percent from the floor, while senior guard Eric Thompson is scoring an average of 11.7 points per game.

Carroll is averaging 77.7 points per game while shooting 46.4 percent from the floor, 35.8 percent on 3-pointers and 71.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 74.8 points per game while shooting 45.7 percent from the floor, 33.6 percent on 3-pointers and 68.5 percent at the free-throw line.

### **Building a Winner:**

In four seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion.



two seasons marks the best two-year win total in men's basketball history. The Green Knights were 37-10 in Mike Heideman's first two years at the helm in 1983 and 1984.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 50-14. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 11-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 9 ranking the week of Feb. 1, 2010.

St. Norbert's 20 wins this season marks just the second time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 14 games in three consecutive seasons. A five-year stretch from 1983-87 is the first occasion. The Green Knights have never won 15 games in three straight seasons.

### D is for Defense:

St. Norbert held its fourth opponent

of the 2009-10 season under 50 points with a 66-48 win over Lawrence on Feb. 2.

The Green Knights lead the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 59.9 points per game. Their defensive mark is good for 12th in the national NCAA Division III statistical rankings. In conference play, St. Norbert allowed a mere 58.6 points per game.

In Gary Grzesk's 93-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 13 times, going 13-0 in those games. It happened twice in 2006-07, four times in 2007-08, three times in 2008-09 and four times this year.

### **Taylor Tidbits:**

St. Norbert junior guard John Taylor is ranked in the top 10 in a pair of NCAA Division III national statistical

categories.

Taylor's 90.0 percent free-throw percentage is eighth nationally, while his 3.03 assist-to-turnover ratio is good for sixth.

In his last 16 games, Taylor has totaled 72 assists against 19 turnovers while manning the point for the Green Knights. Taylor had a career-high nine assists against Ripon on Jan. 9.

### **Jump Shots:**

- \* St. Norbert ranks sixth in this week's NCAA Division III statistical rankings in three-point field-goal percentage defense at 27.2 percent and is 19th in field-goal percentage defense at 39.1 percent.
