St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview NCAA DIVISION III REGIONAL TOURNAMENT

Fri., Feb. 26 - No. 15 St. Norbert College (22-3) vs. Hope (21-7) - 5:30 p.m.
Sat., Feb. 27 - vs. No. 5 UW-Stevens Point (23-5) or Carleton (19-9) - 7 p.m.
Quandt Fieldhouse (3,281) - Stevens Point, Wisconsin

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert College makes its first NCAA Tournament appearance in men's basketball in eight years when it faces Hope College Friday at UW-Stevens Point. UW-Stevens Point and Carleton College round out the four-team regional.

The Series:

Hope leads the series with St. Norbert 1-0. The Flying Dutchmen claimed a 54-53 win over St. Norbert in a first-round NCAA Tournament game on Feb. 28, 2002 at Schuldes Sports Center. Hope's Travis Spaman canned an 18-foot elbow jumper with 0.8 seconds left for the win.

UW-Stevens Point leads St. Norbert 47-27 in a series dating back to 1922-23. The Green Knights and Pointers haven't met since a 76-40 Stevens Point win on Nov. 24, 1992.

St. Norbert leads Carleton 1-0 in the series. St. Norbert claimed an 87-57 win on Jan. 4, 1982 at Schuldes Sports Center.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 63-32 in his fourth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 114-63.

Hope coach Glenn Van Wieren (Hope, 1964) is 660-218 in his 33rd season in Holland.

UW-Stevens Point coach Bob Semling (UW-Eau Claire, 1981) is 113-29 in his fifth season in Stevens Point.

Carleton coach Guy Kalland (Concordia-Moorhead, 1974) is 364-301 in his 26th season in Northfield.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its third NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, and is 1-2 all-time in the tournament. The Green Knights last played in the tournament in 2002, losing 54-53 in a home first-round game to Hope. St. Norbert split a pair of games in 1984, beating North Central 69-56 before losing to eventual national champion UW-Whitewater 87-84 in triple overtime in Whitewater.

Hope is making its 21st NCAA Tournament appearance - including its

fifth-straight - and is 26-22 all-time in the tournament. The Flying Dutchmen have three Final Four trips to their credit, finishing as the national runner-up in 1996 and 1998 and finished third in 2008.

UW-Stevens Point is making its ninth NCAA Tournament appearance and is 19-6 all-time. The Pointers won national championships in 2004 and 2005.

Carleton is making its second NCAA Tournament appearance and is 0-1 all-time.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Tournament at 22-3 overall and ranked 15th in the D3hoops.com Top 25. The Green Knights claimed the Midwest Conference regular-season title at 14-2 and won the league's tournament with an 85-74 win over Carroll this past Saturday.

Junior guard Dave Wipperfurth, who pumped in a career-high 33 points against Carroll in the MWC title game, leads St. Norbert in scoring at 15.2 points per game. Junior center Chris Peterson is averaging 13.7 points and 5.2 rebounds per game. Junior guard John Taylor is totaling 10.7 points and 4.3 assists per game while shooting a lusty 90.5 percent at the free-throw line.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 73.3 points per game, and is shooting 46.2 percent from the floor, 35.6 percent on 3-pointers and 75.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 61.0 points per game while shooting 39.6 percent from the floor, 28.8 percent on 3-pointers and 71.3 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Flying Dutchmen:

Hope enters the NCAA Tournament at 21-7 overall and finished as the runner-up in the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association at 11-3. The Flying Dutchmen won the MIAA Tournament with a 78-74 win over archrival Calvin last Saturday.

Junior guard Peter Bunn leads Hope at 16.3 points per game and is shooting 52.9 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Junior forward

Will Bowser is netting 12.2 points with a team-high 5.8 rebounds per game. Senior center Chris Nelis is averaging 12.3 points with 5.7 rebounds per game.

Hope is averaging 74.5 points per game while shooting 47.2 percent from the floor, 37.6 percent on 3-pointers and 74.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 67.7 points per game while shooting 42.8 percent from the floor, 35.1 percent on 3-pointers and 66.8 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the NCAA Tournament at 23-4 overall. The Pointers were the runner-up in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference at 12-4 but won the WIAC Tournament with a 63-57 road win at UW-Whitewater last Saturday.

Senior guard Matt Moses leads the Pointers at 14.5 points per game, and is shooting 51.3 percent from the floor and 89.9 percent at the free-throw line. Junior forward Louis Hurd is netting 12.4 points per game, while junior guard Jared Jenkins is scoring 10.9 points per game. Junior forward Scott Hoelzel is scoring 8.6 points with a team-high 5.9 rebounds per game.

Stevens Point is scoring an averaging of 75.0 points per game while shooting 49.8 percent from the floor, 36.6 percent on 3-pointers and 74.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 59.9 points per game while shooting 40.8 percent from the floor, 31.3 percent on 3-pointers and 72.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Knights:

Carleton enters the NCAA Tournament with a 19-9 overall record. The Knights finished fourth in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference at 12-8 but ended up beating champion St. Thomas 73-67 in the MIAC tournament semifinals and Gustavus Adolphus 78-71 in overtime for the title.

Junior guard Jeremy Sutherland is averaging a team-high 14.6 points

per game, while junior forward Seth Jonker is scoring 14.1 points per game while shooting 55.8 percent from the floor. Senior forward Bryan Rosett is scoring 11.8 points with a team-high 7.4 rebounds per game.

Carleton is scoring 68.9 points per game while shooting 48.3 percent from the floor, 39.4 percent on 3-pointers and 61.3 percent at the free-throw line. A total of 37.5 percent of the Knights' field-goal attempts are 3-pointers. Opponents are averaging 61.1 points per game while shooting 40.9 percent from the floor, 31.3 percent on 3-pointers and 70.2 percent at the free-throw line.

A March to March:

St. Norbert's first-round NCAA Tournament game on Friday against Hope is the Green Knights' first game in the month of March in 26 years.

The Green Knights have played only three men's basketball games in March since 1968.

St. Norbert last played in March when it played two games in the 1984 NCAA Division III Tournament at UW-Whitewater. The Green Knights fell 87-84 in triple overtime to eventual national champion UW-Whitewater on March 3, 1984 in the regional title game. St. Norbert beat North Central 69-56 the previous day.

The Green Knights also played on March 3, 1980 in a NAIA District 14 Playoff semifinal game, when they lost at UW-Eau Claire 67-42.

Building a Winner:

In four seasons, head coach Gary

Grzesk placed the St. Norbert men's basketball program onto the national Division III scene.

St. Norbert's 22 wins this season is a school record. It marks just the third time in school history it won at least 20 games in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002).

St. Norbert's 40-9 record the last two seasons marks the best two-year win total in men's basketball history. The Green Knights were 37-10 in Mike Heideman's first two years at the helm in 1983 and 1984.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 52-14. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 11-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 9 ranking the week of Feb. 1, 2010.

St. Norbert's 22 wins this season marks just the second time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 14 games in three consecutive seasons. A five-year stretch from 1983-87 is the first occasion. The Green Knights have never won 15 games in three straight seasons.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert held its fourth opponent of the 2009-10 season under 50 points with a 66-48 win over Lawrence on Feb. 2.

The Green Knights lead the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 61.0 points per game. Their defensive mark is good for 18th in the national NCAA Division III statistical rankings. In conference play, St. Norbert allowed a mere 58.6 points per game.

In Gary Grzesk's 95-game tenure at

St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 13 times, going 13-0 in those games. It happened twice in 2006-07, four times in 2007-08, three times in 2008-09 and four times this year.

Taylor Tidbits:

St. Norbert junior guard John Taylor is ranked in the top 10 in a pair of NCAA Division III national statistical categories.

Taylor's 90.5 percent free-throw percentage is fifth nationally, while his 3.0 assist-to-turnover ratio is good for seventh.

In his last 18 games, Taylor has totaled 80 assists against 22 turnovers while manning the point for the Green Knights. Taylor had a career-high nine assists against Ripon on Jan. 9.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert ranks 14th in this week's NCAA Division III statistical rankings in three-point field-goal percentage defense at 28.8 percent and is 23rd in field-goal percentage defense at 39.6 percent.

* - St. Norbert is 6-0 in its last six overtime games, including 2-0 this season.

* - Dave Wipperfurth's 33 points against Carroll on Feb. 27 and Chris Peterson's 32 points against Illinois College on Jan. 22 marked the first time two difference players scored at least 30 points in the same year since Brandon Hansen had 34 points and Aaron Faulkner 33 points as season highs during the 2003-04 season.
