Game Overview

St. Norbert opens the 2010-11 campaign with road games at Marian and UW-Oshkosh.

The Series

St. Norbert owns a 3-3 record against Marian. The Green Knights defeated Marian 78-70 last Nov. 25 at Schuldes Sports Center. David Wipperfurth and Chris Peterson each scored 14 points for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert trails the all-time series with UW-Oshkosh 47-31. The two teams first met during the 1917-18 season. St. Norbert, which has won the last two meetings, defeated UW-Oshkosh 60-52 last Nov. 16 at Schuldes Sports Center. Steve Papke scored 14 points and pulled down eight rebounds for St. Norbert.

The Coaches

St. Norbert head coach **Gary Grzesk** (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 64-33 in his fifth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three season at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 115-64.

Marian head coach **Mark Boyle** is 294-310 in his 23rd season in Fond du Lac.

UW-Oshkosh head coach **Ted Van Dellen** is 343-190 in his 21st season in Oshkosh.

About the Green Knights

St. Norbert, ranked 10th in the D3hoops.com preseason Top 25 poll, is coming off the winningest season in school history during the 2009-10 campaign.

The Green Knights finished 23-4 overall and 14-2 in the Midwest Conference a year ago, and earned a trip to the second-round of the NCAA Division III Tournament. St. Norbert won the Midwest Conference title outright, the third MWC title in school history, and first since the 2001-02 season.

St. Norbert returns 88.4 percent of its scoring from a team that averaged 72.3 points per game a year ago.

Senior David Wipperfurth led St. Norbert in scoring a season ago averaging 15.3 points per game. Senior Chris Peterson chipped in 13.7 points and 5.4 rebounds per contest last season. Senior guard John Taylor netted 10.6 points and dished out 4.3 assists per game a year ago.

Defensively, St. Norbert allowed 61.3 points per game last season. The Green Knights ranked 19th nationally in scoring defense during the 2009-10 season. That total led the Midwest Conference by nearly six points.

About the Sabres

Marian finished 9-16 overall and 6-10 in the Northern Athletic Conference during the 2009-10 season. The Sabres finished fifth in the NAC North Division.

Sophomore guard Jeff Harris is the leading returning scorer from a season ago. Harris averaged 7.4 points a game. Senior center Colin Lohenry returns after netting 6.9 points and grabbing 5.6 rebounds per game.

Marian averaged 68.0 points per game offensively while allowing 71.1 points per game last season.

About the Titans

UW-Oshkosh finished 11-14 overall and 5-11 in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Association a year ago. The Titans return four starters from the 2009-10 campaign.

The Titans lose D3hoops.com second-team All-American D.J. Marsh, but return second-leading scorer Cory Wittwer. Wittwer averaged 10.2 points per game a season ago. Junior guard Greg Schrimpf chipped in 9.2 points per contest last season.

Oshkosh averaged 68.8 points while allowing 67.1 points per contest during the 2009-10 season. The Titans shot 44.5 percent from the floor and 80.6 percent from the free-throw line.

Building a Winner

In four seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk placed the St. Norbert men's basketball program onto the national Division III scene.

St. Norbert's 23 wins a season ago set a school record. It marks just the third time in school history it won at least 20 games in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002).

St. Norbert's 41-10 record the last two seasons marks the best two-year win total in men's basketball history. The Green Knights were 37-10 in Mike Heideman's first years at the helm in 1983 and 1984.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 53-15. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 11-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 9 ranking the week of Feb. 1, 2010.

St. Norbert's 23 wins last season marks just the second time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 14 consecutive in three consecutive seasons. A five-year stretch from 1983-1987 is the first occasion. The Green Knights have never won at least 15 games in three straight seasons.

Pick Me a Winner

Over the past two seasons St. Norbert has compiled a 41-10 overall record. That mark is good for an .803 winning percentage. The Green Knights have the 13th-best winning percentage in Division III basketball since the 2008-09 season.

St. Norbert has won five straight games, and eight of the last nine against teams from the Northern Athletic Conference.

The Green Knights last lost a game to a NAC school on Nov. 16, 2007 when St. Norbert dropped a 58-52 overtime game at Concordia-Chicago.

St. Norbert head coach Gary Grzesk is 36-15 all-time against teams from the NAC.

Road Warriors

St. Norbert is 19-7 over the past 26 games on the road. The Green Knights finished 9-2 on the road a year ago after finishing 7-3 away from home during the 2008-09 season. St. Norbert was 3-2 over the final five games of the 2007-08 season.

Home Sweet Home

St. Norbert has enjoyed much success in home games in past seasons. Since 1957-58, the Green Knights have gone 369-196 in home contests, good for a 65.3 winning percentage. In those years, St. Norbert has only had a losing record in home games six times, and has never suffered a losing streak longer than four games. The Green Knights are 37-12 in its last 49 games played at Schuldes Sports Center.

GRZESK

Gary Grzesk will be in his fifth season as St. Norbert College's men's basketball coach in 2010-11.

St. Norbert is 64-33 in four years under Grzesk's supervision. Grzesk piloted the Green Knights to a 23-4 record, setting a school record for wins. St. Norbert advanced to the second round

of the NCAA Division III Tournament, its first national post-season win in 26 years. The Green Knights won the Midwest Conference regular-season and tournament titles, and were ranked as high as No. 9 in the D3hoops.com Top 25.

The 2008-09 season was also a highly successful season for the Green Knights, who finished 18-6 overall and 12-4 in the Midwest Conference. St. Norbert rose to as high as No. 11 in the D3hoops.com Top 25 and also topped No. 1-ranked UW-Platteville in the championship game of the Nicolet Bank Holiday Classic, the first win over a No. 1 foe for any sport in St. Norbert history.

In three seasons at Lakeland from 2004 to 2006, Grzesk compiled a 51-31 record. The Muskies won the Lake Michigan Conference championship in 2006 and also captured the LMC Tournament title in 2004. Lakeland also appeared in the 2004 NCAA Division III Tournament.

Grzesk spent the 2002-03 season as an assistant at UW-Green Bay, his alma mater. Prior to returning to Green Bay, Grzesk was an assistant at Youngstown State (Ohio) University for six seasons from 1996-97 to 2001-02. Grzesk was an aide during Youngstown State's first 20-win season as a Division I member when the Penguins went 20-9 in 1997-98.

A 1996 graduate of UW-Green Bay, Grzesk was a four-year letterwinner for the Phoenix. He earned the team's Defensive Player of the Year award four times, helping Green Bay to three NCAA Tournament appearances. Grzesk is perhaps best known for guarding NBA lottery pick Jason Kidd in a 61-57 NCAA Tournament first-round win over California in 1994. Grzesk, who started in 107 of the 120 collegiate games he played in, was Green Bay's captain his junior and senior seasons. He concluded his career with 450 points and 496 assists. The Phoenix was 74-19 in Grzesk's final three seasons.
