St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview MIDWEST CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

Fri., Feb. 25 - No. 20 St. Norbert (18-5) vs. Ripon (14-9) - 8 p.m.
Sat., Feb. 26 - Championship vs. Illinois College (16-7) or Grinnell (17-6) - 6 p.m.
Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Tournament Overview:

The winner of the Midwest Conference Tournament will receive the league's automatic qualifier into the NCAA Division III Tournament.

The Series:

Ripon holds a 59-45 series lead over St. Norbert in a hotly contested rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have won the last eight of the last nine meetings. Ripon is 2-1 against St. Norbert all-time in the MWC Tournament, winning the 1999 and 2002 championship games before St. Norbert claimed a MWC semifinal win last year.

St. Norbert leads Illinois College 25-7 in an all-time series dating back to the 1986-87 season. The Green Knights have won the last nine games in the series and are 15-1 at home against the Blueboys all-time.

St. Norbert leads Grinnell 19-12 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights are 13-3 at home against the Pioneers all-time.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 82-38 in his fifth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 133-69.

Ripon coach Bob Gillespie (Lewis, 1971) is 494-240 in his 31st season in Ripon.

Illinois College coach Mike Worrell (Urbana, 1986) is 154-193 in his 15th season in Jacksonville.

Grinnell coach David Arseneault (Colby, 1976) is 275-229 in his 22nd season in Grinnell.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the tournament at 18-5 overall after winning the Midwest Conference championship with a 14-4 record - the first time the Green Knights have ever won consecutive league titles. St. Norbert has won nine of its last 11 games following a 66-55 win over Lawrence this past Saturday.

Senior guard Dave Wipperfurth leads St. Norbert in scoring at 14.3 points per game. Wipperfurth has 1,090 career points and needs just 13 points to

move into 15th on the St. Norbert career scoring list. Senior guard John Taylor is netting 10.3 points per game, while senior center Chris Peterson is scoring 9.8 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 68.1 points per game, and is shooting 45.6 percent from the floor, 36.0 percent on 3-pointers and 69.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 57.8 points per game while shooting 39.8 percent from the floor, 31.5 percent on 3-pointers and 70.3 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the tournament 14-9 overall and 12-6 in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks have won three of their last four games, including an 86-61 win over Beloit this past Saturday.

Junior forward Aris Wurtz leads Ripon in scoring at 21.2 points per game and has 6.6 rebounds per game. Senior guard Scott Gillespie is averaging 18.4 points per game with 7.8 assists per game. The two players have accounted for 50.4 percent of Ripon's shots and 49.3 percent of the Red Hawks' points. Sophomore guard Taylor Koth has enjoyed a breakout season at 13.8 points and 8.8 rebounds per game.

Ripon is averaging 80.3 points per game while shooting 49.0 percent from the floor, 34.0 percent on 3-pointers and 74.9 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 76.7 points per game while shooting 43.9 percent from the floor, 35.5 percent on 3-pointers and 69.3 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Blueboys:

Illinois College enters the tournament at 16-7 overall, its most wins in a year since going 16-9 in 1977-78. The Blueboys finished in a three-way tie for second in the MWC with a 12-6 record.

Junior forward Craig Bals leads an explosive Illinois College offense at 16.5 points per game. Senior guard Jacob Tucker is scoring 15.0 points per game while grabbing 7.1 rebounds per game. Sophomore

guard Nathan Kohler is scoring 14.5 points per game while freshman forward Brandon Berry is netting 10.1 points per game.

Illinois College is scoring an average of 80.7 points per game while shooting a league-best 50.6 percent from the floor, 39.5 percent on 3-pointers and 67.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 74.5 points per game while shooting 44.5 percent from the floor, 36.2 percent on 3-pointers and 67.2 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Grinnell enters the tournament at 17-6 overall and 12-6 in the MWC. The Pioneers are the hottest team in the league at present, winning their last nine games. Grinnell has scored less than 100 points in six of those nine wins.

Sophomore forward Griffin Lentsch leads the Pioneers in scoring at 19.1 points per game and has made 95 3-pointers this year. Junior forward Matt Skelly is scoring 12.8 points per game, while junior guard Matt Chalupa is scoring 12.4 points per game. Freshman forward Aaron Levin is the fourth Pioneer to scoring in double figures at 11.3 points per game.

Grinnell is averaging 104.9 points per game while shooting 39.5 percent from the floor, 32.5 percent on 3-pointers and 66.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 94.6 points per game while shooting 58.6 percent from the floor, 34.0 percent on 3-pointers and 66.8 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In five seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that has maintained consistent mention in the D3hoops.com Top 25 Poll.

St. Norbert's 20 wins last season marks just the third time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights have won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

three seasons marks the best three-year win total in men's basketball history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 68-20. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 12-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 18 wins this season marks just the first time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 15 games in three consecutive seasons. The Green Knights have won at least 18 games in each of the last three years.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert held its seventh opponent of the 2010-11 season under 50 points with a 60-46 win over Carroll on Feb. 12.

The Green Knights lead the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 57.8

points per game. Their defensive mark is good for sixth out of 402 teams in the national NCAA Division III statistical rankings. In conference play, St. Norbert has allowed 59.3 points per game.

In Gary Grzesk's 120-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 20 times, going 20-0 in those games. It happened twice in 2006-07, four times in 2007-08, three times in 2008-09 and four times in 2009-10 and seven times this year..

Jump Shots:

* - Since 1957-58, St. Norbert has gone 379-198 in home contests, good for a .657 winning percentage. In those years, St. Norbert has only had a losing record at home games in six seasons, and has never suffered a home losing

streak longer than four games. The Green Knights are 47-14 in its last 61 games played at Schuldes Sports Center.

* - St. Norbert senior guard John Taylor is second in the NCAA Division III statistical rankings in assist-to-turnover ratio. Taylor's 4.25 ratio is second to only Grinnell's Scott Kaitz's 5.3. Taylor has 102 assists to 24 turnovers this season.

* - St. Norbert is 7-0 in its last seven overtime games. Its lone overtime game was a 91-82 double-overtime affair against Illinois College on Jan. 22.

* - St. Norbert's overall road record of 8-3 this year is the only above-.500 road mark in the MWC. Illinois College, Grinnell, Ripon and Carroll were the only other teams to be at .500, all at 5-5 away from home.
