St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview NCAA DIVISION III TOURNAMENT - MIDWEST REGIONAL Fri., Mar. 4 - No. 16 St. Norbert (20-5) vs. No. 3 UW-Stevens Point (24-3) - 5:30 p.m. Sat., Mar. 5 - vs. No. 24 Concordia-Wis. (23-4) or Luther (18-8) - 7 p.m. Buuck Field House (2,000) - Mequon, Wisconsin

Tournament Overview:

Three nationally ranked teams converge on the shores of Lake Michigan in an NCAA Division III Regional. St. Norbert and UW-Stevens Point meet in the tournament for the second consecutive year, while Concordia makes its first NCAA appearance since 2000 and Luther its first trip since 1984.

The Series:

UW-Stevens Point leads St. Norbert 48-27 in a series dating back to 1922-23. The Pointers won the last meeting by a 63-48 score in the second round of last year's NCAA Division III Tournament.

St. Norbert leads Concordia 22-12 in an all-time series dating back to the 1923-24 season. The Falcons topped St. Norbert 57-56 in the last meeting on Dec. 3, 2003 in Mequon.

St. Norbert leads Luther 1-0 in the all-time series. The Green Knights topped the Norse 72-68 during the 1953-54 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 84-38 in his fifth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 135-69.

UW-Stevens Point coach Bob Semling (UW-Eau Claire, 1981) is 143-32 in his sixth season in Stevens Point.

Concordia coach Shawn Cassidy (Concordia-Wis., 1993) is 65-39 in his fourth season in Mequon.

Luther coach Mark Franzen (Wartburg, 1994) is 49-75 in his fifth season in Decorah.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its fourth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance, and is 2-3 all-time in the tournament. Two of St. Norbert's previous three appearances ended at the hands of the eventual national champion - UW-Whitewater in 1984 and UW-Stevens Point in 2010.

UW-Stevens Point is making its tenth NCAA Tournament appearance and is 25-6 all-time. The Pointers won national championships in 2004, 2005 and 2010.

1 in the tournament. The Falcons lost 72-54 to eventual national runner-up UW-Eau Claire in 2000.

Luther is making its making its third NCAA Tournament appearance. The Norse are 1-3 all-time, making appearances in 1982 and 1984

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Tournament at 20-5 overall after winning the Midwest Conference Tournament with an 89-67 win over Grinnell this past Saturday in De Pere. The Green Knights have won 11 of their last 13 games.

Senior guard David Wipperfurth leads St. Norbert in scoring at 14.9 points per game. Wipperfurth scored 44 points in the two games in the Midwest Conference Tournament, including 25 in a 75-52 semifinal win over Ripon. Senior guard John Taylor is netting 10.1 points per game, while senior center Chris Peterson is scoring 9.5 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 69.2 points per game, and is shooting 45.9 percent from the floor, 35.4 percent on 3-pointers and 69.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 58.0 points per game while shooting 39.6 percent from the floor, 29.8 percent on 3-pointers and 69.7 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point, the defending national champion, enters the NCAA Tournament at 24-3. The Pointers, who have won 12 consecutive games, won the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference at 14-2. Stevens Point beat UW-River Falls 79-56 in the WIAC Tournament championship game on Saturday.

Sophomore guard Jerrel Harris leads the Pointers in scoring at 15.3 points per game and is shooting 53.8 percent from the floor and 45.5 percent (40-for-88) on three-point field goal attempts. Senior forward Louis Hurd is netting 11.4 points per game while shooting 52.3 percent from the floor.

Stevens Point is averaging 80.0 points per game while shooting 52.6 percent from the floor, currently tops in Division III. The Pointers also shooting 39.4 percent on 3-pointers and 70.7 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 57.6 points per game (sixth in Division III) while shooting 39.8 percent from the floor, 31.8 percent on 3-pointers and 66.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Falcons:

Concordia enters the NCAA Tournament at 23-4 overall. The Falcons won the Northern Athletics Conference North Division with a 16-0 regular-season record but lost 95-89 in the semifinals of the NAC Tournament to Edgewood.

Senior guard Edward "Skip" Newton-Kemp leads the Falcons in scoring at 16.6 points per game. Junior guard Luke Doedens, a transfer from Division II Winona State, averages 14.6 points per game while shooting 51.2 percent from the floor. Junior guard Mitchell Schneider averages 14.3 points per game, while senior center Cory Stark averages 12.9 points and 6.8 rebounds per game.

Concordia is scoring an average of 81.6 points per game while shooting 47.5 percent from the floor, 35.6 percent on 3-pointers and 73.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 70.0 points per game while shooting 44.4 percent from the floor, 32.6 percent on 3-pointers and 71.0 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Norse:


Luther enters the NCAA Tournament with an 18-8 overall record. The Norse won the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference title with a 13-3 record, its first since 1984. Luther beat Dubuque 57-48 on Saturday to win the IIAC Tournament.

Junior guard Dane Larson leads Luther in scoring at 15.7 points per game, and is the only player to average double figures in scoring. Sophomore center Tyler Wedemeier averages 9.6 points and 7.2

rebounds per game.

Luther is averaging 65.3 points per game while shooting 44.3 percent from the floor, 36.0 percent on 3-pointers and 68.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 59.3 points per game while shooting 40.6 percent from the floor, 29.5 percent on 3-pointers and 68.9 percent at the free-throw line.

Wipp It:

St. Norbert senior guard David Wipperfurth is enjoying another banner season, netting 14.9 points with 3.4 rebounds per game.

Wipperfurth enters the NCAA Tournament with 1,134 career points in 98 games to stand 15th among St. Norbert's career leaders. Wipperfurth is only the fourth player in school history to score at least 1,100 career points since St. Norbert moved into Schuldes Sports Center in 1979.

Dating back to last season's Midwest Conference and NCAA tournaments, Wipperfurth is averaging 21.5 points per game in his last six post-season games. Wipperfurth scored 19 points against Grinnell and 25 against Ripon in last weekend's MWC Tournament. Last year, Wipperfurth scored 15 points against UW-Stevens Point and 19 against Hope in the NCAA Tournament. He added 33 points against Carroll and 18 against Ripon in the MWC Tournament.

Wipperfurth is the first St. Norbert cager to earn first-team All-Midwest Conference honors in two consecutive years since Nathan Hoffmann repeated

in 2001 and 2002.

Building a Winner:

In five seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that has maintained consistent mention in the D3hoops.com Top 25 Poll.

St. Norbert's 20 wins this season marks just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights have won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 61-15 record the last three seasons marks the best three-year win total in men's basketball history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 73-20. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 12-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 20 wins this season marks just the first time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 15 games in three consecutive seasons. The Green Knights have won at least 18 games in each of the last three years.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert held its seventh opponent of the 2010-11 season under 50 points with a 60-46 win over Carroll on Feb. 12.

In the Midwest Conference Tournament last weekend, St. Norbert held a powerful Ripon offense to just 52 points and national scoring leader Grinnell - which averaged 102.9 points per game - to only 67. St. Norbert held Grinnell to 85, 79 and 67 points in three meetings this year, becoming the first team ever to hold the Pioneers' frenetic offense to under 100 points three times in the same year.

In its last five games excluding a pair of Grinnell games, St. Norbert is holding foes to just 50.4 points per game.

The Green Knights lead the Midwest Conference in scoring defense at 58.0 points per game. Their defensive mark is good for eighth out of 402 teams in the national NCAA Division III statistical rankings. St. Norbert is 12th in field-goal percentage defense at 38.6 percent.

In Gary Grzesk's 122-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 20 times, going 20-0 in those games. It happened twice in 2006-07, four times in 2007-08, three times in 2008-09 and four times in 2009-10 and seven times this year..

Jump Shots:

- * St. Norbert senior guard John Taylor is second in the NCAA Division III statistical rankings in assist-to-turnover ratio. Taylor's 3.83 ratio is second to only Grinnell's Scott Kaitz's 4.56. Taylor has 111 assists to 29 turnovers this season.
- * St. Norbert is 7-0 in its last seven overtime games. Its lone overtime game was a 91-82 double-overtime affair against Illinois College on Jan.
