St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (6-5, 3-3) vs. Ripon College (8-2, 4-1) Tuesday, January 10, 2012 - 7:30 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert prepares for battle when it hosts Ripon at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights are currently in fourth place and trail the thirdplace Red Hawks by two games in the loss column in the conference standings.

The Series:

Ripon holds a 59-46 series lead over St. Norbert in a spirited rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have narrowed the gap by winning nine of the last ten meetings over the last four seasons. St. Norbert is 6-0 at home in the series during that stretch.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Ripon 75-52 in a Midwest Conference Tournament semifinal game last Feb. 25 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. David Wipperfurth paced St. Norbert with 25 points, while John Taylor chipped in with 14 points. Taylor Koth had 14 points to lead Ripon, while Scott Gillespie set the Ripon career scoring record during the game with 13 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 90-44 in his sixth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 141-74.

Ripon coach Bob Gillespie (Lewis, 1971) is 502-243 in his 32nd season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game at 6-5 overall and 3-3 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights have lost three of their last four games, including a 74-64 setback Saturday at Carroll. St. Norbert is 4-2 on its home floor this season.

Sophomore guard Brandon Gries leads St. Norbert in scoring with 12.8 points per game. Sophomore center Garrett Thorn is scoring 11.6 points per game while shooting 62.3 percent from the floor. Junior forward Paul Appleton is scoring 11.4 points per game, while freshman forward Andrew

Schwoerer is scoring 10.3 points while grabbing a team-high 5.5 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 69.5 points per game, and is shooting 42.9 percent from the floor, 30.7 percent on 3-pointers and 73.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 66.1 points per game while shooting 42.7 percent from the floor, 32.9 percent on 3-pointers and 72.6 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game with an 8-2 overall record and a 4-1 ledger in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks are off to their best start since a 9-1 sprint out of the gate to open the 2004-05 season. Ripon's last outing was last Wednesday with an 83-73 win at Illinois College

Scoring ace Aris Wurtz, a senior forward, paces the Red Hawks at a robust 25.1 points per game, and is two points shy of 1,500 for his career. Junior guard Taylor Koth is averaging a double-double so far this season, compiling totals of 20.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game. Junior guard Zach Meulemans is averaging 13.4 points per game and is shooting 48.3 percent from threepoint range.

Ripon is averaging 84.1 points per game while shooting 47.7 percent from the floor, 38.1 percent on 3pointers and 78.4 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 73.5 points per game while shooting 41.7 percent from the floor, 29.4 percent on 3-pointers and 66.1 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first five seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that maintained consistent mention in the D3hoops.com Top 25 Poll.

St. Norbert's 20 wins last season marks just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights have won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010. St. Norbert's 61-16 record from 2009 to 2011 marks the best threeyear win total in men's basketball history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 76-26. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 12-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 20 wins last season marked the first time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 15 games in three consecutive seasons. The Green Knights have won at least 18 games in each of the last three years, and for the first time won at least 20 games in consecutive seasons.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert has almost made more free throws this season (171) than its opponents have attempted (179). The Green Knights have gotten to the stripe more than their opponents in all but three games, and are 0-3 in those contests (108-98 loss at Grinnell, a 78-57 loss to UW-La Crosse and a 74-64 loss to Carroll).

* - St. Norbert owns a 2-4 record this season when it has a lower field-goal percentage than its opponent. The Green Knights topped Beloit 73-63 on Dec. 7 despite getting outshot 41.1 percent to 51.8 percent, and also defeated Northland 71-53 on Dec. 29 with a 40.0 percent to 41.3 percent difference.

* - St. Norbert is 1-4 this season when allowing 70 points or more. The Green Knights' lone win in that situation came in an 80-70 win over Beloit on Dec. 7.


* - In Gary Grzesk's 134-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 22 times, going 22-0 in those games.

* - St. Norbert is 7-0 in its last seven overtime games. Its lone overtime game last season was a victorious 91-82 double-overtime affair against Illinois College on Jan. 22.
