St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (10-6, 7-4) vs. Lawrence Univ. (5-9, 4-6) Wednesday, January 25, 2012 - 7:30 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert attempts to remain in the mix for a spot in the four-team Midwest Conference Tournament when it hosts Lawrence Wednesday at Schuldes Sports Center.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lawrence 47-40 in an all-time series dating back to the 1917-18 season, making it one of the Green Knights' two oldest rivalries. The Green Knights have won four straight games in the series, including season sweeps the past two years.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert beat Lawrence 66-55 on Senior Day last Feb. 19 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. John Taylor paced the Green Knights with 18 points, while David Wipperfurth added 13 points and Chris Peterson 11. Lawrence was led by Jon Mays' 17 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 94-45 in his sixth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 145-76.

Lawrence coach Joel DePagter (Lawrence, 1998) is 68-43 in his fifth season in Appleton.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game having won four of its last five games to sport a 10-6 overall record and 7-4 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights split a pair of games on a brutal road trip to Illinois last weekend, losing 62-54 at Lake Forest on Friday before beating Illinois College 73-55 on Saturday.

Sophomore guard Brandon Gries keeps the Green Knights' scoring lead at 12.4 points per game. Junior forward Paul Appleton is netting 10.8 points per game, while freshman forward Andrew Schwoerer is scoring 10.3 points while grabbing a team-high 5.7 rebounds per game. Sophomore center Garrett Thorn chips in with 9.3 points and 5.3 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 68.9 points per game, and is shooting

43.9 percent from the floor, 33.9 percent on 3-pointers and 73.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 64.4 points per game while shooting 42.5 percent from the floor, 32.2 percent on 3-pointers and 67.9 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the game with a 5-9 overall record and 4-6 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings have won two of their last three games but lost 98-74 at Grinnell on Saturday. Lawrence beat Monmouth 67-63 on Jan. 14 and Knox 92-83 last Friday.

Sophomore guard Chris Siebert leads the Vikings in scoring at 17.4 points per game, and is shooting 87.7 percent at the free-throw line. Senior guard Tyler Crisman is scoring 14.5 points per game, while sophomore forward Davis DeWolfe is netting 11.9 points with a teamhigh 5.4 rebounds per game.

Lawrence is averaging 72.1 points per game while shooting 43.7 percent from the floor, 36.8 percent on 3-pointers and 65.8 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 79.8 points per game while shooting 44.2 percent from the floor, 34.8 percent on 3-pointers and 77.3 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first five seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that remains near the top of the Midwest Conference standings.

St. Norbert's 20 wins last season marks just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 61-16 record from 2009 to 2011 marks the best threeyear win total in men's basketball history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 80-27. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 12-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6

ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 20 wins last season marked the first time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 15 games in three consecutive seasons. The Green Knights have won at least 18 games in each of the last three campaigns, and for the first time in school history won at least 20 games in consecutive seasons.

Charity Chatter:

St. Norbert is shooting a respectable 73.5 percent at the freethrow line this season, a mark that puts the Green Knights second in the Midwest Conference. Ripon leads the league at 78.5 percent.

The Green Knights have made 227 of 309 free-throw attempts this season. Opponents are 190-for-280 (67.9 percent).

Three St. Norbert starters have are currently connecting on at least 80 percent of their free-throw attempts this season. Freshman forward Andrew Schwoerer leads the team at 82.1 percent (32-for-39) followed by sophomore guard Brandon Gries at 81.3 percent (61for-75). Junior forward Paul Appleton is third at 80.6 percent (25-for-31).

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert's scoring defense of 64.4 points per game is second in the Midwest Conference to Lake Forest's 59.3 points per game.

* - St. Norbert is 2-4 this season when allowing 70 points or more. The Green Knights' lone wins in that situation came in an 80-70 win over Beloit on Dec. 7 and a 79-70 win over Illinois College on Jan. 13. Both of those games were at home.

* - In Gary Grzesk's 139-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 22 times, going 22-0 in those games.

* - St. Norbert is 7-0 in its last seven overtime games. Its lone overtime game last season was a victorious 91-82 double-overtime affair against Illinois College on Jan. 22.
