St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview
St. Norbert College (14-8, 11-6) at Lawrence University (9-12, 8-9)
Saturday, February 18, 2012 - 2 p.m.
Alexander Gym (1,100) - Appleton, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert faces Lawrence in both teams' regular-season finale. The Green Knights will clinch the No. 3 seeding for next weekend's Midwest Conference Tournament with a win.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lawrence 48-46 in an all-time series dating back to the 1917-18 season, making it one of the Green Knights' two oldest rivalries. The Green Knights have won five straight games in the series, including season sweeps the past two years.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Lawrence 74-65 on Jan. 25 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Green Knights led 32-22 at halftime and by as many as 21 points in the second half. Brandon Gries led St. Norbert with 16 points and 10 rebounds, while Andrew Schwoerer added 15 points. Tyler Crisman led Lawrence with 17 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 98-47 in his sixth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 149-78.

Lawrence coach Joel DePagter (Lawrence, 1998) is 72-46 in his fifth season in Appleton.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game at 14-8 overall and an 11-6 record in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, who have won eight of their last 11 games, have been idle since a 65-62 win over Carroll last Saturday in De Pere. That win clinched a berth in the Midwest Conference Tournament for the Green Knights.

Sophomore guard Brandon Gries leads St. Norbert in scoring at 14.1 points per game after scoring 24 points in the win over Carroll. Freshman forward Andrew Schwoerer, who has missed the last two games, has collected 11.6 points and 6.1 rebounds per game. Junior forward Paul Appleton is netting 10.4 points per game this season. Garrett Thorn is scoring 9.6 points with 5.1 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 70.2 points per game, and is shooting 44.9 percent from the floor, 34.6 percent on 3-pointers and 70.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 66.1 points per game while shooting 42.9 percent from the floor, 34.5 percent on 3-pointers and 68.3 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters Saturday's game with a 9-12 overall record and an 8-9 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings have won four of their last six games, including a 77-69 win at archrival Ripon this past Wednesday.

Sophomore guard Chris Siebert leads the Vikings in scoring at 17.0 points per game. Senior guard Tyler Crisman is averaging 15.9 points per game. Sophomore forward Davis DeWolfe is scoring 10.6 points with 5.9 rebounds per game. Junior forward Conor Klusendorf is averaging 10.1 points per game.

Lawrence is averaging 73.4 points per game while shooting 44.2 percent from the floor, 37.1 percent on 3-pointers and 68.4 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 78.4 points per game while shooting 44.8 percent from the floor, 34.1 percent on 3-pointers and 73.9 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first six seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that remains near the top of the Midwest Conference standings.

St. Norbert's 20 wins last season marks just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 61-16 record from 2009 to 2011 marks the best threeyear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 84-29. St. Norbert reached its highest national

ranking in the 12-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 20 wins last season marked the first time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 15 games in three consecutive seasons. A win Saturday would give the Green Knights their first four-season stretch of winning at least 15 games in each year.

St. Norbert's string of five straight seasons with at least 10 Midwest Conference wins is also the best mark in school history.

Shooting Story:

St. Norbert has improved its shooting from the floor to an advantage of 44.9 percent to 42.9 percent on its opponents in fieldgoal percentage this season.

Twelve times this season St. Norbert has outshot its opponent, and 10 times the Green Knights have misfired more than their foes.

St. Norbert holds a 11-1 record when outshooting its opponent. The exception came predictably against Grinnell, a game the Green Knights lost 108-98 despite shooting 60.9 percent.

The Green Knights are 3-7 when getting outshot, getting wins against Beloit 73-63, Northland 71-53 and Knox 60-58.

Jump Shots:

- * St. Norbert's scoring defense of 66.2 points per game is second in the Midwest Conference to Lake Forest's 60.8 points per game.
- * St. Norbert is 3-4 this season when allowing 70 points or more. The Green Knights' lone wins in that situation came in an 80-70 win over Monmouth on Dec. 7, a 79-70 win over Illinois College on Jan. 13 and a 97-96 win over Grinnell on Feb. 4.
- * In Gary Grzesk's 145-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 22 times, going 22-0 in those games.
- * St. Norbert's 8-1 home record this season was tied for the best mark in the league with Lake Forest.
