St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview MIDWEST CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT Fri., Feb. 24 - St. Norbert (15-8) vs. Grinnell (18-4) - 7:30 p.m. Sat., Feb. 25 - Championship vs. Lake Forest (20-3) or Carroll (14-9) - 3 p.m. LFC Sports Center (1,200) - Lake Forest, Illinois

Tournament Overview:

The winner of the Midwest Conference Tournament will receive the league's automatic qualifier into the NCAA Division III Tournament.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Grinnell 21-13 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season.

St. Norbert leads Lake Forest 33-20 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights have won eight of the last 11 games in the series.

Carroll leads St. Norbert 44-39 in a series dating back to the 1933-34 season. The Green Knights have won the last four of the last five meetings.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 98-47 in his sixth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 149-78.

Grinnell interim coach David N. Arseneault (Grinnell, 2009) is 10-4 in his first season in Grinnell. He is the son of head coach David Arseneault, who is currently on sabbatical leave this semester.

Lake Forest coach Chris Conger (Wisconsin, 1995) is 186-184 in his 16th season in Lake Forest.

Carroll coach Dave Buchanan (UW-La Crosse, 1995) is 42-29 in his third season in Waukesha. Including three seasons at UW-Superior, Buchanan is 72-76 in six seasons overall.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the tournament 15-8 overall and is the No. 3 seeding after finishing with a 12-6 record in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, who have won nine of their last 12 games, topped Lawrence 80-65 last Saturday in their regular-season finale.

Sophomore guard Brandon Gries leads St. Norbert in scoring at 14.2 points per game. Freshman forward Andrew Schwoerer has posted totals of 11.9 points and 6.1 rebounds per game. Junior forward Paul Appleton is scoring 10.4 points per game this season. Sophomore center Garrett Thorn is scoring 9.6 points with 5.4 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 70.7 points per game, and is shooting 45.1 percent from the floor, 35.3 percent on 3-pointers and 69.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 66.0 points per game while shooting 42.9 percent from the floor, 35.0 percent on 3-pointers and 68.0 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Pioneers:

Grinnell enters the tournament with an 18-4 overall record and finished second in the Midwest Conference with a 14-4 mark. The Pioneers have lost three of their last five games but did beat conference champion Lake Forest for the second time this season with a 112-101 win on Saturday.

Junior guard Griffin Lentsch, who scored 32 points in a 97-96 loss to St. Norbert on Feb. 4, leads Grinnell in scoring at 26.6 points per game. Freshman guard Luke Yaeger is averaging 11.0 points per game, while sophomore guard Patrick Maher is netting 10.1 points and 5.2 assists per game.

Grinnell is averaging 112.1 points per game while shooting 43.6 percent from the floor, 35.2 percent on 3-pointers and 70.0 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 98.1 points per game while shooting 57.9 percent from the floor, 39.1 percent on 3-pointers and 66.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the tournament at 20-3 overall and won the league title for the first time since 2000 with a 16-2 mark. The 20-win season is the first time the Foresters have reached that plateau in school history.

Senior center Travis Clark, the top candidate for MWC Player of the Year, paces the Foresters at 17.7 points and 10.1 rebounds per game. Clark is shooting 62.9 percent from the floor. Sophomore guard James Stack is averaging 11.1 points per game while shooting 52.7 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Senior forward Nate Bateman is averaging 10.6 points per game. Lake Forest is averaging 71.3 points per game while shooting 46.7 percent from the floor, 36.2 percent on 3-pointers and 68.8 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 62.2 points per game while shooting 38.8 percent from the floor, 29.1 percent on 3-pointers and 69.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers II:

Carroll enters the tournament at 14-9 overall and 10-8 in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers got the fourth spot in the league tournament on a tiebreaker over Ripon after topping Illinois College 76-73 last Saturday.

Sophomore center Alec Molter leads the Pioneers at 14.8 points and 8.4 rebounds per game, and is shooting 57.7 percent from the floor. Sophomore guard Kevin Hurd is scoring 11.8 points per game, while senior guard Kyle jones is netting 10.9 points per game.

Carroll is averaging 75.6 points per game while shooting 48.9 percent from the floor, 38.2 percent on 3-pointers and 68.7 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 71.8 points per game while shooting 41.4 percent from the floor, 29.6 percent on 3-pointers and 73.8 percent at the free-throw line.

Gries is the Word:

Sophomore guard Brandon Gries has enjoyed a solid stretch during the Green Knights' last 12 games. Gries has played in 11 of those contests, and has scored a team-high 15.6 points per game during that stretch.


Gries is shooting 50 percent (53for-106) from the floor, 53.7 percent (22-for-41) on 3-pointers and 77.2 percent (44-for-57) at the free-throw line. He also has 37 assists to 18 turnovers.

In his last six games, Gries has scored double digits in each game, with three games of 21 points or better. He is averaging 19.2 points per game during those six games. He had 25 points in a 68-64 loss at Ripon on Jan. 28 and 24 points with eight rebounds in a 65-62 win over

Building a Winner:

In his first six seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that remains near the top of the Midwest Conference standings.

St. Norbert's 20 wins last season marks just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 61-16 record from 2009

to 2011 marks the best three-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 85-29. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in history the 12-year of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 20 wins last season marked the first time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 15 games in three consecutive seasons. Last Saturday's win over Lawrence gave the Green Knights their first-ever four-season stretch of winning at least 15 games in each year.

St. Norbert's string of five straight seasons with at least 10 Midwest Conference wins is also the best mark in school history.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert's defense of 66.0 points per game is second in the MWC to Lake Forest's 62.2 points per game.

* - St. Norbert is 3-4 this season when allowing 70 points or more. The Green Knights' lone wins in that situation came in an 80-70 win over Monmouth on Dec. 7, a 79-70 win over Illinois College on Jan. 13 and a 97-96 win over Grinnell on Feb. 4.

* - In Gary Grzesk's 145-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 22 times, going 22-0 in those games.
