St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (5-2, 3-1) vs. Lake Forest College (6-1, 3-0) Saturday, December 17, 2011 - 3 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert squares off against Lake Forest in both teams' last game before Christmas in a key Midwest Conference battle Saturday at Schuldes Sports Center.

Broadcast:

The game will be broadcast live on WACY-TV 32 with Ted Stefaniak and Dean Leisgang on the call. WACY is available to Time Warner Cable customers in Northeast Wisconsin on Channel 13.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lake Forest 33-18 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights have won eight of the last nine games in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Lake Forest 60-46 last Jan. 21 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere in a game that lasted just 1 hour 15 minutes. David Wipperfurth led St. Norbert with 19 points, while John Taylor added 12 points. Jeff Beck led the Foresters with eight points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 89-41 in his sixth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 140-72.

Lake Forest coach Chris Conger (Wisconsin, 1995) is 172-182 in his 16th season in Lake Forest. Conger is a Green Bay native and a graduate of Southwest High School.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game at 5-2 overall and 3-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights boast a modest three-game winning streak, and have been idle since beating Knox 76-57 on the road last Saturday.

Junior forward Paul Appleton has taken over the team scoring lead at 13.4 points per game, and is shooting 52.5 percent from the floor. Sophomore guard Brandon Gries is netting 13.3 points per game. - MORE -

Sophomore forward Garrett Thorn is averaging 10.6 points per game while shooting 65.9 percent from the floor. Freshman forward Andrew Schwoerer is scoring 9.7 points per game while grabbing a team-high 5.4 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 74.3 points per game, and is shooting 45.4 percent from the floor, 32.4 percent on 3-pointers and 72.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 66.1 points per game while shooting 39.8 percent from the floor, 28.2 percent on 3-pointers and 74.8 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the game on a six-game winning streak, standing at 6-1 overall and 3-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Foresters lost their season opener to Edgewood 61-54 but have posted impressive non-conference wins with a 63-58 defeat of Chicago on Nov. 22 and a 63-60 victory over Carthage on Dec. 6.

Senior center Travis Clark paces the Foresters, scoring 18.4 points per game while shooting 65.2 percent from the floor. Clark is the top rebounder in the Midwest Conference at 10.9 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard James Stack is scoring 10.7 points per game and is shooting 50 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Junior guard Jeff Beck is netting 10.6 points per game.

Lake Forest is averaging 67.6 points per game while shooting 44.7 percent from the floor, 34.5 percent on 3-pointers and 69.7 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 60.0 points per game while shooting 38.7 percent from the floor, 27.1 percent on 3-pointers and 64.0 percent at the free-throw line.

Gries is the Word:

St. Norbert sophomore guard Brandon Gries had perhaps his best game at the collegiate level in last Saturday's 76-57 win at Knox.

Gries finished the game with his first career double-double, netting 14 points and 10 rebounds. He also finished with four steals, three assists and no turnovers in 30 minutes of action.

Gries, who is averaging 13.3 points per game, also leads the Green Knights in getting to the three-throw line. Gries' percentage of 82.6 percent leads the squad, canning 38 of 46 attempts. Gries' 46 attempts is tied with Ripon scoring ace Aris Wurtz for the Midwest Conference lead.

Building a Winner:

In his first five seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that maintained consistent mention in the D3hoops.com Top 25 Poll.

St. Norbert's 20 wins last season marks just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights have won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 61-16 record from 2009 to 2011 marks the best threeyear win total in men's basketball history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 75-23. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 12-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 20 wins last season marked the first time in school history the Green Knights have won at least 15 games in three consecutive seasons. The Green Knights have won at least 18 games in each of the last three years, and for the first time won at least 20 games in consecutive seasons.

Jump Shots:

* - In Gary Grzesk's 130-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 22 times, going 22-0 in those games.

* - St. Norbert is 7-0 in its last seven overtime games. Its lone overtime game last season was a victorious 91-82 double-overtime affair against Illinois College on Jan. 22.
