St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview NICOLET NATIONAL BANK HOLIDAY TOURNAMENT

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert hosts the Sixth Annual Nicolet National Bank Holiday Tournament at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights are searching for their first Nicolet Bank title since beating then-No. 1 UW-Platteville in the 2008 championship game. Admission to the tournament is free.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Marian 4-3 in the all-time series, which began in the 1988-89 season.

UW-Whitewater leads St. Norbert 9-3 in a series begun during the 1933-34 season. The two programs have not met since 1984, but are scheduled to meet later this season in a rare February non-conference game on Feb. 2 in Whitewater. The Green Knights' last win in the series came by a 95-89 count on Dec. 5, 1975 in Whitewater.

Northwestern leads St. Norbert 1-0 in a series started during the 2009-10 season.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert beat Marian 67-55 on Nov. 15, 2011 at Sadoff Gymnasium in Fond du Lac. The Green Knights, who led 28-26 at halftime, led by as many as 25 points in the second half. Paul Appleton led St. Norbert with 12 points, while D.J. Vaughn had 14 points for the Sabres.

In one of the best games in both programs' history, UW-Whitewater topped St. Norbert 87-84 in triple overtime in the NCAA Division III Tournament's Round of 16 on March 3, 1984 at Whitewater's Williams Center. The Warhawks went on to win the national championship that season. All five of Dave Vander Meulen's five starters reached double figures, with Andre McKoy's 30 points leading the Warhawks. Mike Heideman's Green Knights were led by 27 points from Joe Emmerich, who - along with McKoy - played all 55 minutes.

Northwestern topped St. Norbert 72-70 in a first-round Nicolet Bank Tournament game on Dec. 29, 2009 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere.

Eric Garst led Northwestern with 18 points, while David Wipperfurth had 18 for St. Norbert.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 105-51 in his seventh season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 156-82.

Marian coach Mark Boyle (UW-Eau Claire, 1978) is 312-353 in his 25th season in Fond du Lac.

UW-Whitewater coach Pat Miller (UW-Whitewater, 1989) is 246-75 in his 12th season in Whitewater.

Northwestern coach Tim Grosz (Northwestern, 1992) is 236-125 in his 13th season in Roseville.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the tournament at 5-3 overall. The Green Knights won consecutive games for the first time this season when they topped Lawrence 70-52 on Dec. 15 and Carroll 69-55 on Dec. 19.

Sophomore forward Andrew Schwoerer, the reigning Midwest Conference Player of the Week, has scored at least 21 points in each of his last three games to boost his average to 16.8 points per game. Junior guard Brandon Gries is netting 14.6 points per game, while senior forward Paul Appleton is scoring 8.0 points per game. Freshman forward Izaiah Anderson is scoring 6.9 points per game with a team-high 6.9 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 71.2 points per game, and is shooting 45.6 percent from the floor, 33.3 percent on 3-pointers and 74.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 63.6 points per game while shooting 42.9 percent from the floor, 35.1 percent on 3-pointers and 72.8 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Sabres:

Marian enters the tournament with a 4-6 overall record. The Sabres have been idle since Dec. 18, when it won at Martin Luther 90-78 in double overtime. Marian owns a 76-74 win over Ripon on Nov. 24

and lost at Lawrence 83-76 on Nov. 21.

Junior forward Cody Veleke leads the Sabres with 14.4 points per game and 5.4 rebounds per game. Junior guard Sam Koslowski is netting 12.1 points per game, while freshman guard Drew Binversie is averaging 9.3 points per game.

Marian is averaging 72.3 points per game while shooting 43.3 percent from the floor, 35.6 percent on 3-pointers and 68.0 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 73.4 points per game while shooting 43.9 percent from the floor, 36.3 percent on 3-pointers and 66.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Warhawks:

UW-Whitewater enters the tournament 9-1 and is ranked No. 6 in the latest D3hoops.com Top 25. The Warhawks dispatched Edgewood 75-48 on Dec. 22. Whitewater, the defending NCAA Division III national champion, suffered its only loss on Dec. 12 to UW-Stevens Point 72-61.

Sophomore guard Quardell Young leads the Warhawks in scoring at 11.7 points per game. Senior forward Luke Knoble averages 11.6 points and 5.3 rebounds per game. Junior guard Eric Bryson nets 11.0 points per game. Sophomore guard K.J. Evans scores 10.4 points per game, while freshman forward Darnell Harris nets 10.2 points per game.

Whitewater is averaging 74.4 points per game while shooting 47.5 percent from the floor, 34.2 percent on 3-pointers and 67.0 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 62.3 points per game while shooting 44.3 percent from the floor, 39.1 percent on 3-pointers and 74.2 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Eagles:

Northwestern enters the tournament 7-2 overall, and is receiving votes in the D3hoops.com Top 25. The Eagles have been idle since Dec. 14, when they toppled then No. 9-Wheaton 67-62. Northwestern is also 2-0 against the WIAC this season, beating UW-River Falls 78-69 on Nov. 17 and

Senior guard Wade Chitwood leads the Eagles in scoring at 17.1 points per game. Senior guard Tom Gisler is averaging 14.2 points per game and is shooting 51.1 percent from the floor. Freshman forward Matt Watnemo is scoring 10.7 points per game.

Northwestern is averaging 79.4 points per game while shooting 46.3 percent from the floor, 38.8 percent on 3-pointers and 65.7 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 74.7 points per game while shooting 47.8 percent from the floor, 36.4 percent on 3-pointers and 63.6 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first six seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that remains near the top of the Midwest Conference standings.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2011 marked just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 77-25 record from 2009 to 2012 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 94-33. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 16 wins last season gave the Green Knights a stretch of four consecutive seasons with at least 15 wins, the first time in school history that has happened.

St. Norbert's string of five straight years with at least 10 Midwest Conference wins is also the best mark in school history.

Jump Shots:

* - In Gary Grzesk's 156-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 24 times, going 24-0 in those games.

* - St. Norbert is 0-2 this season and was 4-5 last season when allowing 70 points or more.
