St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (9-3, 6-2) vs. Illinois College (7-6, 4-4) Saturday, January 12, 2013 - 3 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert tries to extend its six-game winning streak when it hosts Illinois College. The Green Knights are engaged in a three-way tie for first place in the Midwest Conference standings.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Illinois College 27-7 in an all-time series dating back to the 1986-87 season. The Green Knights have won the last 11 games in the series and are 16-1 all-time at home against the Blueboys.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Illinois College 73-55 last Jan. 21 at Bruner Center in Jacksonville, Ill. The Green Knights trailed 9-2 before going on a 29-3 run over a 13-minute stretch to take command. Jack Whalen led St. Norbert with 14 points, while Andrew Schwoerer added 13 points. Brandon Berry led the Blueboys with eight points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 109-51 in his seventh season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 160-82.

Illinois College coach Mike Worrell (Urbana, 1986) is 167-217 in his 17th season in Jacksonville.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game at 9-3 overall and 6-2 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights have won six straight games following a 72-43 win at Ripon on Wednesday, the largest margin of victory ever for St. Norbert on the Red Hawks' home floor.

ing at 14.3 points per game while shooting 56.2 percent from the floor. Junior guard Brandon Gries is scoring 13.4 points per game and dished out a career-high eight assists in the win over Ripon. Senior forward Paul Appleton, who averages 9.4 points per game, finished three points of matching a career high with 23 points against the Red Hawks.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 69.9 points per game, and is shooting 45.0 percent from the floor, 36.6 percent on 3-pointers and 70.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 58.8 points per game while shooting 41.6 percent from the floor, 35.4 percent on 3-pointers and 70.3 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Blueboys:

Illinois College enters the game 7-6 overall with a 4-4 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Blueboys, who have two conference losses by two points and another by six points, are coming off a 78-62 win over Knox at home on Wednesday. Illinois College has won three of its last four games.

Junior guard Nathan Kohler leads the Blueboys in scoring at 16.7 points per game, and is also averaging 5.3 assists per game. Junior forward Brandon Berry is netting 14.3 points per game with 5.8 rebounds per game. Senior center Isaac Grapperhaus is averaging 13.8 points per game with 5.5 rebounds per game.

Illinois College is averaging 78.7 points per game while shooting 46.6 percent from the floor, 36.1 percent on 3-pointers and 72.2 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 69.0 points per game while shooting 43.6 percent from the floor, 31.1 percent on 3-pointers and 69.0 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first six seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that remains near the top of the Midwest Conference standings.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2011 marked just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 77-25 record from 2009 to 2012 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 98-33. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 16 wins last season gave the Green Knights a stretch of four consecutive seasons with at least 15 wins, the first time in school history that has happened.

St. Norbert's string of five straight years with at least 10 Midwest Conference wins is also the best mark in school history.

Dialing Up Defense:

St. Norbert is allowing a Midwest Conference-best 58.8 points per game, well ahead of Illinois College's 69.0 points per game. Omitting St. Norbert's 105 points allowed to Grinnell on Dec. 8, the Green Knights are allowing just 54.6 points per game this season.

In Gary Grzesk's 160-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 26 times, going 26-0 in those games.

St. Norbert allowed 43 points to Ripon in its 72-43 win over the Red Hawks on Wednesday. It was the fewest amount of points the Green Knights have allowed in a Midwest Conference game since a 62-42 win over Monmouth on Feb. 4, 2011.

- * St. Norbert is 0-2 this season and was 4-5 last season when allowing 70 points or more.
