St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (13-3, 10-2) at Knox College (1-15, 1-10) Saturday, January 26, 2013 - 3 p.m.

Memorial Gym (2,000) - Galesburg, Illinois

Game Overview:

St. Norbert attempts to extend its 10-game winning streak when it travels to Knox. The Green Knights hold a one-game lead in the Midwest Conference with six league games remaining.

Broadcast:

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Knox 27-10 in a series dating back to the 1985-86 season. The Green Knights have won eight straight games in the series since the Prairie Fire swept the season series in the 2007-08 season.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert survived a 60-58 triumph over Knox on Jan. 14, 2012 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Green Knights got a defensive stop on the last possession of the game to seal the win. Paul Appleton led St. Norbert with 16 points, while Andrew Schwoerer added 11 points and Jack Whalen 10. Ben Wetherbee led Knox with 17 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 113-51 in his seventh season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 164-82.

Knox coach Kevin Walden (Knox, 2001) is 1-15 in his first season in Galesburg.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend on a 10-game winning streak (see pull box on next page) following a 64-48 win over Lake Forest on Wednesday. The Green Knights are 13-3 overall and 10-2 in the Midwest Conference to reside in first place alone.

Junior guard Brandon Gries leads the Green Knights in scoring at 14.3 points per game. Sophomore forward Andrew Schwoerer is averaging 13.2 points and 5.3 rebounds per game. Senior forward Paul Appleton is averaging 9.9 points per game and has made a team-high 32 3-pointers. Freshman forward Izaiah Anderson is averaging 7.6 points and a team-high 6.8 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 71.5 points per game, and is shooting 46.9 percent from the floor, 36.9 percent on 3-pointers and 71.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 58.2 points per game while shooting 40.8 percent from the floor, 35.5 percent on 3-pointers and 70.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Prairie Fire:

Knox enters the game at 1-15 overall and 1-10 in the Midwest Conference. The Prairie Fire has lost 11 straight games since an 84-80 win over Cornell on Dec. 4. Knox is coming off a 90-72 loss at Cornell on Wednesday.

Sophomore guard Mitch Murphy leads the Prairie Fire in scoring at 14.5 points per game. Senior forward Lukas Shaw is averaging 11.3 points and a team-high 6.1 rebounds per game. Junior forward David Jones is netting 8.6 points per game with 6.0 rebounds per game.

Knox is averaging 63.0 points per game while shooting 39.6 percent from the floor, 32.3 percent on 3pointers and 61.0 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 84.9 points per game while shooting 51.8 percent from the floor, 35.8 percent on 3-pointers and 70.6 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first six seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that remains near the top of the Midwest Conference standings.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2011 marked just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984)

and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 77-25 record from 2009 to 2012 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 102-33. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 16 wins last season gave the Green Knights a stretch of four consecutive seasons with at least 15 wins, the first time in school history that has happened.

St. Norbert's string of six straight years with at least 10 Midwest Conference wins is also the best mark in school history.

Dialing Up Defense:

St. Norbert is allowing a Midwest Conference-best 58.2 points per game (good for 16th in the most recent NCAA Division III statistical rankings), well ahead of Lake Forest's 68.3 points per game. During St. Norbert's 10-game winning streak, the Green Knights have allowed more than 59 points just once - in an 80-63 win over Cornell on Jan. 19.

In Gary Grzesk's 164-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 27 times, going 27-0 in those games.

St. Norbert allowed 43 points to Ripon in its 72-43 win over the Red Hawks on Jan. 9. It was the fewest amount of points the Green Knights have allowed in a Midwest Conference game since a 62-42 win over Monmouth on Feb. 4, 2011.

In seven road games this season, St. Norbert is allowing just a scant 51.6 points per game.

St. Norbert Men's Basketball Winning Streaks

St. Norbert's current 10-game winning streak is just the fifth of at least that length for the Green Knights since the conclusion of World War II. All five have come since St. Norbert left independent status and joined the Midwest Conference for basketball in 1983. Three have come during Gary Grzesk's seven-year tenure as head coach.
