St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (16-5, 13-3) vs. Ripon College (13-9, 11-6) Tuesday, February 12, 2013 - 7 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert plays its final regular-season home game when it hosts rival Ripon on Tuesday at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights can capture a share of their third Midwest Conference title in four years with wins over Ripon and Saturday at Illinois College.

The Series:

Ripon holds a 60-48 series lead over St. Norbert in a spirited rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have narrowed the gap by winning 11 of the last 13 meetings over the last six seasons.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Ripon 72-43 on Jan. 9 at Storzer Center in Ripon in the largest winning margin on the road ever in the series for the Green Knights. The Red Hawks held a 27-26 lead early in the second half before St. Norbert went on a decisive 19-0 run. Paul Appleton led St. Norbert with 23 points, and Andrew Schwoerer added 12 points. Taylor Koth led Ripon with 14 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 116-53 in his seventh season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 167-84.

Ripon coach Ryan Kane (St. Norbert, 1999) is 13-9 in his first season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads into the final week of the regular season at 16-5 overall and 13-3 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights fell into a firstplace tie atop the MWC with Grinnell after dropping a 104-99 overtime

heartbreaker to the Pioneers this past Saturday.

Junior guard Brandon Gries leads the Green Knights in scoring at 13.7 points per game. Sophomore forward Andrew Schwoerer, who scored 26 points against Grinnell, averages 13.4 points per game and is shooting 56.1 percent from the floor. Senior forward Paul Appleton is averaging 9.4 points per game, while freshman forward Izaiah Anderson is averaging 7.1 points and a team-high 6.3 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 71.1 points per game, and is shooting 46.5 percent from the floor, 36.9 percent on 3-pointers and 74.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.1 points per game while shooting 40.2 percent from the floor, 34.4 percent on 3-pointers and 72.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game with a 13-9 overall record and an 11-6 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks could clinch a spot in the Midwest Conference with a win over St. Norbert. Ripon won for the fifth straight game with a 79-72 win over Illinois College Saturday at home.

Senior guard Taylor Koth, who scored 32 points against Illinois College, has led Ripon in scoring in all but one game this season and averages 24.5 points and 9.7 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Kyle Loughrin is averaging 10.9 points per game. Junior forward Brad Brooks is averaging 9.2 points and 6.1 rebounds per game.

Ripon is averaging 72.2 points per game while shooting 44.4 percent from the floor, 29.9 percent on 3pointers and 74.3 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 73.0 points per game while shooting 43.9 percent from the floor, 33.6 percent on 3-pointers and 69.8 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first six seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2011 marked just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 77-25 record from 2009 to 2012 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 105-35. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 16 wins in 2011-12 gave the Green Knights a stretch of four consecutive seasons with at least 15 wins, the first time in school history that has happened.

St. Norbert's string of six straight years with at least 10 Midwest Conference wins is also the best mark in school history.

Dialing Up Defense:

St. Norbert is allowing a Midwest Conference-best 60.1 points per game, good for 12th in the most recent NCAA Division III statistical rankings. The Green Knights have allowed more than 63 points only once in their last 15 games, and have yielded more than 59 points just three times .

St. Norbert allowed 43 points to Ripon in its 72-43 win over the Red Hawks on Jan. 9. It was the fewest amount of points the Green Knights have allowed in a Midwest Conference game since a 62-42 win over Monmouth on Feb. 4, 2011.

In Gary Grzesk's 169-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 28 times, going 28-0 in those games.
