St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview MIDWEST CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

Fri., Feb. 22 - St. Norbert (18-5) vs. Ripon (13-10) - 7 p.m.
Sat., Feb. 23 - Championship vs. Grinnell (17-5) or Carroll (17-6) - 3 p.m.
Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert, making its Midwest Conference-best sixth consecutive conference tournament appearance, hosts Grinnell, Carroll and Ripon this weekend. The Green Knights, who have won three out of the last four MWC titles, are vying for their third NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in four years. The MWC Tournament champion receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The Series:

Ripon holds a 60-49 series lead over St. Norbert in a spirited rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have narrowed the gap by winning 12 of the last 14 meetings over the last six seasons.

St. Norbert leads Grinnell 23-16 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights are 15-3 all-time at home in the series.

Carroll leads St. Norbert 45-41 in a series dating back to the 1933-34 season. The Green Knights have won the last six of the last eight meetings.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 118-53 in his seventh season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 169-84.

Ripon coach Ryan Kane (St. Norbert, 1999) is 13-10 in his first season in Ripon.

Grinnell coach David Arseneault (Colby, 1976) is 311-240 in his 24th season in Grinnell.

Carroll coach Dave Buchanan (UW-La Crosse, 1995) is 62-36 in his fourth season in Waukesha.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads into the Midwest Conference Tournament at 18-5 overall and won the MWC with a 15-3 league mark. The Green Knights eked out the league title with a 70-68 win Saturday at Illinois College. It is St. Norbert's fifth overall MWC title.

The Green Knights are led in scoring by junior guard Brandon Gries, who is averaging 13.9 points per game. Sophomore forward Andrew Schwoerer, who scored 20 points in the win over Illinois College, is averaging 13.4

points per game while shooting 55.7 percent from the floor. Senior forward Paul Appleton is averaging 9.5 points per game and has made a team-high 42 3-pointers this season.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 70.5 points per game, and is shooting 46.1 percent from the floor, 36.5 percent on 3-pointers and 73.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.1 points per game while shooting 40.2 percent from the floor, 33.8 percent on 3-pointers and 73.5 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the tournament with a 13-10 overall record and an 11-7 mark in MWC to finish in a fourth-place tie with Lawrence. The Red Hawks, who advanced to the post-season by sweeping the Vikings this season, have been idle since Feb. 12 when they lost 57-52 at St. Norbert after holding a 15-2 lead.

Senior guard Taylor Koth leads the Midwest Conference in scoring at 24.0 points per game, and is also averaging 9.7 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Kyle Loughrin is averaging 10.8 points per game. Junior forward Brad Brooks is averaging 9.5 points and 6.1 rebounds per game.

Ripon is averaging 71.3 points per game while shooting 44.0 percent from the floor, 29.4 percent on 3-pointers and 74.7 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 72.3 points per game while shooting 43.6 percent from the floor, 33.3 percent on 3-pointers and 69.6 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers I:

Grinnell enters the MWC Tournament at 17-5 overall and finished second in the league at 14-4. The Pioneers could have earned the MWC Tournament's No. 1 seeding Saturday with a win at Lawrence, but fell 114-106 in overtime.

Senior guard Griffin Lentsch leads the Pioneers in scoring at 19.0 points per game. Sophomore guard Luke Yeager is averaging 13.3 points per game, while junior guard Patrick Maher is netting 11.6 points per game. Junior forward Aaron Levin is averaging 10.0 points per game. Sophomore guard Jack Taylor averaged 36.3 points per game before being lost for the season after suffering a wrist injury at Cornell on Jan. 9.

Grinnell is scoring a Division III-

best average of 113.4 points per game, and is shooting 42.4 percent from the floor, 33.4 percent (400-for-1,198) on 3-pointers and 74.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 96.4 points per game while shooting 55.0 percent from the floor, 39.3 percent on 3-pointers and 68.0 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers II:

Carroll enters the tournament with a 17-6 overall record and a 13-5 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers have won three straight games after a 95-61 win Saturday at home over Knox.

Junior forward Alec Molter leads the Pioneers in scoring at 11.8 points per game while shooting 56.6 percent from the floor, and also grabs 7.7 rebounds per game. Junior guard Kevin Hurd is averaging 10.4 points per game and is shooting 52.1 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Senior guard Jake Bast is averaging 10.0 points per game.

Carroll is averaging 74.7 points per game while shooting 49.3 percent from the floor, 41.8 percent on 3-pointers and 70.9 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 66.5 points per game while shooting 40.3 percent from the floor, 33.1 percent on 3-pointers and 71.4 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first seven seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2011 marked just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 77-25 record from 2009 to 2012 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 107-35. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 16 wins in 2011-12 gave the Green Knights a stretch of four consecutive seasons with at least 15 wins, the first time in school history that had happened.

Dialing Up Defense:

St. Norbert is allowing a Midwest Conference-best 60.1 points per game. The Green Knights have allowed more than 63 points only twice in their last 17 games.

St. Norbert allowed 43 points to Ripon in its 72-43 win over the Red Hawks on Jan. 9. It was the fewest amount of points the Green Knights have allowed in a Midwest Conference game since a 62-42 win over Monmouth on Feb. 4, 2011.

In Gary Grzesk's 171-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 28 times, going 28-0 in those games.

Active Appleton:

St. Norbert senior forward Paul Appleton reached an historic mile-

stone on Feb. 12 against Ripon when he became the first player in school history to play in 100 career games.

Appleton, who started the first game of his collegiate career as a freshman in 2009-10, has never missed a game in his St. Norbert career for 101 career games.

David Wipperfurth (2008-11) played in 99 career games but missed two games due to injury his junior season.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert's Midwest Conference title this season is its fourth since 2002. In those 12 years, the Green Knights' four outright MWC titles are the second most in the league. Only Lawrence has more with five titles, with four of those outright. Grinnell has three titles, while Lake Forest has one.

* - St. Norbert is the first team to win a MWC title starting conference play 2-2 since Grinnell had starts of 0-2 and 1-3 in 2006-07 en route to a 13-3 finish.

* - St. Norbert is 20-4 all-time at home under Gary Grzesk against this year's tournament field. The Green Knights are 8-1 against Ripon, 6-1 against Grinnell and 6-2 against Carroll.

* - Since 1957-58, St. Norbert has gone 402-202 in home contests, good for a .663 winning percentage. In those 56 years, St. Norbert has only had a losing record at home games in six seasons, and has never suffered a home losing streak longer than four games. The Green Knights are 70-18 in its last 88 games played at Schuldes Sports Center.
