St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview NCAA DIVISION III MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT - FIRST ROUND St. Norbert College (20-5) at No. 22 Wheaton College (20-6) Saturday, March 2, 2013 - 7 p.m. King Arena (2,650) - Wheaton, Illinois

Game Overview:

St. Norbert, making its third NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in four years, travels to the Land of Lincoln to face Wheaton in the first round of the 2013 NCAA Division III Tournament. The winner will advance to the second round on March 9 to face the winner of St. Thomas-Aurora.

The Series:

St. Norbert and Wheaton are tied 4-4 in the all-time series, which dates back to the 1939-40 season. The two schools have not met on the hardwood since Dec. 5, 1992, with St. Norbert claiming a 76-73 win at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. St. Norbert and Wheaton have met once previously in the post-season. Wheaton topped St. Norbert 68-66 on March 7, 1958 in the first round of the NCAA College Division (presently Division II) Tournament in Aurora. Ill.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 120-53 in his seventh season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 171-84.

Wheaton coach Mike Schauer (Wheaton, 1993) is 80-30 in his fourth season in Wheaton. Including two seasons at Eastern and seven seasons at Gordon, Schauer is 226-123 in 13 seasons as a college coach.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its fifth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its third in four seasons, and is 2-4 all-time in the tournament. Two of St. Norbert's previous four appearances ended at the hands of the eventual national champion - UW-Whitewater in 1984 and UW-Stevens Point in 2010. The Green Knights lost to Stevens Point in the first round in 2011 by a 70-49 score.

Wheaton is making its ninth NCAA Division III appearance and its fifth in six years. The Thunder is 10-8 all-time in the tournament. Wheaton was eliminated in last year's tournament in the Sweet 16 by eventual national champion UW-Whitewater 67-56. Wheaton also made four appearances in the NCAA College Division (now Division II) Tournament, going 11-4 in four appearances with a national title in 1957.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Division III Tournament with a 20-5 overall record, and have won 17 of its last 19 games. The Green Knights, who won the Midwest Conference title with a 15-3 record, captured the MWC Tournament crown with a 92-68 win over Carroll Saturday in De Pere. It marked the third time in four years the Green Knights have swept the MWC regular-season and tournament championships.

The Green Knights are led in scoring by junior guard Brandon Gries, who has upped his season average to 14.4 points per game. Sophomore forward Andrew Schwoerer is averaging 13.4 points per game with 5.8 rebounds per game, and is shooting 56.4 percent from the floor to rank 46th nationally. Senior forward Paul Appleton comes off the bench to average 9.2 points per game. Freshman forward Izaiah Anderson is averaging 7.2 points per game while grabbing a team-high 6.3 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 71.5 points per game, and is shooting 46.7 percent from the floor, 36.2 percent on 3-pointers and 74.5 percent at the free-throw line. St. Norbert's free-throw percentage ranked 23rd nationally. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.6 points per game while shooting 40.3 percent from the floor, 33.3 percent on 3-pointers and 72.9 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Thunder:

Wheaton enters the NCAA Division III Tournament with a 20-6

overall record and ranked No. 22 in the D3hoops.com Top 25. The Thunder finished third in the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin with a 10-4 record. Wheaton, who is 14-1 at King Arena this season, lost in the semifinals of the CCIW Tournament by a 59-50 score to North Central.

Junior guard Tyler Peters was a unanimous first-team All-CCIW selection this season by averaging 19.3 points per game while shooting 55.2 percent from the floor. Sophomore guard Brayden Teuscher, a third-team All-CCIW choice, averaging 13.4 points per game. Junior forward Nathan Haynes, a second-team All-CCIW honoree, averages a double-double at 10.6 points and 10.8 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Michael Kvam is averaging 10.7 points per game.

Wheaton is averaging 70.5 points per game while shooting 46.2 percent from the floor, 39.4 percent on 3-pointers - good for 14th nationally - and 69.2 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 59.8 points per game while shooting 41.5 percent from the floor, 33.1 percent on 3-pointers and 67.0 percent at the free-throw line.

Gries is the Word:

St. Norbert junior guard Brandon Gries is enjoying another banner season, averaging 14.4 points per game while also distributing an average of 3.7 assists per game. Gries' scoring average ranks tenth in the Midwest Conference, and his assist total is good for sixth in the league.

Gries has led St. Norbert in scoring in 14 of its 25 games this season. He has led the Green Knights in rebounding just twice, but both came in the MWC Tournament with 10 in a 75-65 win over Ripon and nine in a 92-68 win over Carroll.


In his last seven games, Gries is averaging 16.6 points per game, with the high during that stretch 21 points in the MWC Tournament championship game against Carroll.

Tournament with 815 career points in 75 career games for a lifetime average of 10.9 points per game. Barring injury, Gries stands to become only the fifth player to score at least 1,100 career points since St. Norbert moved into Schuldes Sports Center in 1979.

Gries is the second St. Norbert cager to earn first-team All-Midwest Conference honors in two consecutive seasons in the last 12 years. David Wipperfurth was also a back-to-back first-team All-MWC selection in 2010 and 2011.

Schwoerer Stuff:

St. Norbert sophomore forward Andrew Schwoerer has become a potent weapon offensively for the Green Knights in his two seasons in De Pere.

Schwoerer has scored 618 points in 48 career games, an average of 12.9 points per game. Schwoerer is also a 54.5 percent career shooter, making 262 of 481 lifetime field-goal attempts while mostly facing the basket.

Schwoerer, who was the D3hoops.com Midwest Region Rookie of the Year last season, has a team-high five 20-point games this season. Schwoerer's most recent such game came in the Midwest Conference regular-season championship clincher with 20 points in a 70-68 win at Illinois College on Feb. 16.

Active Appleton:

St. Norbert senior forward Paul Appleton reached an historic milestone on Feb. 12 against Ripon when he became the first player in school history to play in 100 career games.

Appleton, who started the first game of his collegiate career as a freshman in 2009-10, has never missed a game in his St. Norbert career for 103 career games.

Appleton has scored 717 career points and is a career 37.2 percent shooting from beyond the three-point arc, making 113 of 304 attempts.

David Wipperfurth (2008-11) was the closest to playing in 100 career games, but he played in only 99 career games after missing two games due to injury his junior season.

Building a Winner:

In his first seven seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship.

The Green Knights have won 20 games three times in the last four years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2013 marked just the fifth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010. St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011.

St. Norbert's 77-25 record from 2009 to 2012 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 109-35. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 16 wins in 2011-12 gave the Green Knights a stretch of four consecutive seasons with at least 15 wins, the first time in school history that had happened.

Dialing Up Defense:

St. Norbert is allowing a Midwest Conference-best 60.6 points per game. The Green Knights' mark is good for 25th nationally out of 407 teams in the Division III statistical rankings.

St. Norbert allowed 43 points to Ripon in its 72-43 win over the Red Hawks on Jan. 9. It was the fewest amount of points the Green Knights have allowed in a Midwest Conference game since a 62-42 win over Monmouth on Feb. 4, 2011.

In Gary Grzesk's 173-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 28 times, going 28-0 in those games.
