St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (1-1, 0-0) vs. Beloit College (1-2, 0-0) Wednesday, November 28, 2012 - 7 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert College opens Midwest Conference action this season when it faces Beloit Wednesday at Schuldes Sports Center for the Green Knights' first game in eight days.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Beloit 35-23 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights have won eight of the last 11 meetings in the series.

Last Meeting:

Beloit tipped St. Norbert 69-65 in overtime last Feb. 8 at Flood Arena in Beloit. David Bremner led the Buccaneers with 25 points, while James Lazarcik had nine points and 18 rebounds. Garrett Thorn had 18 points and Jack Whalen added 16 points for the Green Knights.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 101-49 in his seventh season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 152-80.

Beloit coach Brian Vraney (Wisconsin, 1998) 36-82 in his sixth season in Beloit.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters its Midwest Conference opener at 1-1 overall. The Green Knights have been idle for eight days, not playing since a 74-60 loss to College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin foe Augustana last Tuesday at Schuldes Sports Center.

Junior guard Brandon Gries is the only Green Knight to average scoring in double figures at 16.0 points per game. Sophomore forward Andrew - MORE -

Schwoerer is averaging 9.5 points per game, while junior center Garrett Thorn is netting 7.5 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 69.5 points per game, and is shooting 45.7 percent from the floor, 35.5 percent on 3-pointers and 82.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 61.5 points per game while shooting 39.6 percent from the floor, 30.3 percent on 3-pointers and 76.3 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Buccaneers:

Beloit enters tonight's contest at 1-2 overall. The Buccaneers are coming off their first win of the season, topping Dominican 87-82 on Saturday at Flood Arena in Beloit.

Junior forward James Lazarcik has enjoyed a torrid start to the season, scoring 23.3 points per game while grabbing 10.3 rebounds per game. Lazarcik is shooting a lusty 83.3 percent (30-for-36) from the floor. Junior forward Tyler Butke is scoring 15.0 points per game while shooting 56.8 percent from the field.

Beloit is averaging 78.3 points per game while shooting 54.2 percent from the floor, 27.3 percent on 3-pointers and 65.3 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 83.0 points per game while shooting 49.1 percent from the floor, 49.1 percent on 3-pointers and 78.9 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first six seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that remains near the top of the Midwest Conference standings.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2011 marked just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 77-25 record from 2009 to 2012 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 90-31. St.

Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 16 wins last season gave the Green Knights a stretch of four consecutive seasons with at least 15 wins, the first time in school history that has happened.

St. Norbert's string of five straight years with at least 10 Midwest Conference wins is also the best mark in school history.

Pre-Season Prognostications:

Midwest Conference men's basketball coaches have pegged St. Norbert to have another successful season, picking the Green Knights to finish first in this year's pre-season Coaches' Poll.

St. Norbert received eight first-place votes to earn the nod as the pre-season favorite, totaling 98 points. Carroll earned the other three first-place votes and was picked for second with 91 points. Grinnell was picked for third with 84 points, while Lake Forest was tabbed for fourth with 65 points.

Illinois College and Lawrence were picked to finish in a tie for fifth with 49 points, while Ripon was close behind in seven with 48 points.

Beloit and Monmouth were tied for eighth with 43 points, Cornell 10th with 24 points and Knox 11th with 11 points.

Jump Shots:

- * In Gary Grzesk's 150-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 23 times, going 23-0 in those games.
- * St. Norbert is 0-1 this season and was 4-5 last season when allowing 70 points or more. The Green Knights' wins in that situation came in an 80-70 win over Monmouth on Dec. 7, a 79-70 win over Illinois College on Jan. 13, a 97-96 win over Grinnell on Feb. 4 and a 103-83 rout of Grinnell on Feb. 24.
