St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (4-3, 3-2) at Carroll Univ. (7-2, 3-1) Wednesday, December 19, 2012 - 7 p.m. Van Male Fieldhouse (2,000) - Waukesha, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert faces another key Midwest Conference road game when it heads to Waukesha to face Carroll. The Green Knights trail the Pioneers by one game in the loss column in the league standings.

Broadcast:

The Series:

Carroll leads St. Norbert 45-39 in a series dating back to the 1933-34 season. The Green Knights have won the last four of the last six meetings, but Carroll took two of three games from St. Norbert last season.

Last Meeting:

Carroll defeated St. Norbert 87-65 in the championship game of the Midwest Conference Tournament last Feb. 25 in Lake Forest, Ill. The Pioneers jumped out to a 51-22 halftime lead and never looked back. Kevin Hurd led four Carroll players in double figures with 22 points, while Jack Whalen paced the Green Knights with 19 points off the bench.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 104-51 in his seventh season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 155-82.

Carroll coach Dave Buchanan (UW-La Crosse, 1995) is 52-32 in his fourth season in Waukesha. Including three seasons at UW-Superior, Buchanan is 82-79 in seven seasons overall.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters Wednesday's game at 4-3 overall and 3-2 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights are coming off perhaps their best game of the season - a 70-52 win at Lawrence this past Saturday.

Sophomore forward Andrew Schwoerer has moved into the team scoring lead after a perfect afternoon against Lawrence, scoring 23 points on 9-for-9 shooting from the floor and 4-for-4 at the free-throw line. Schwoerer is

averaging 16.1 points per game and is shooting a blistering 63.0 percent from the floor. Junior guard Brandon Gries is the only other Green Knight scoring in double figures at 15.0 points per game. Senior forward Paul Appleton comes off the bench to score 7.3 points per game, while freshman Izaiah Anderson is scoring 6.9 points per game with a team-high 6.4 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 71.6 points per game, and is shooting 46.3 percent from the floor, 33.3 percent on 3-pointers and 75.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 64.9 points per game while shooting 43.2 percent from the floor, 35.3 percent on 3-pointers and 73.1 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the St. Norbert game at 7-2 overall and 3-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers were surprised at home Saturday by Ripon in a 79-76 loss to the Red Hawks. Carroll's only other loss this season came in a 93-83 setback to nationally ranked North Central on Nov. 24.

Junior guard Kevin Hurd leads a balanced Carroll offense at 10.6 points per game. Senior forward Dan Kratz is scoring 9.7 points per game, while senior guard Jake Bast is netting 9.2 points per game. Junior center Alec Molter is also averaging 9.2 points per game while grabbing 5.3 rebounds per game.

Carroll is averaging 75.1 points per game while shooting 48.5 percent from the floor, 44.4 percent on 3-pointers and 73.2 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 68.2 points per game while shooting 44.0 percent from the floor, 38.9 percent on 3-pointers and 64.8 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first six seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into a conference champion that remains near the top of the Midwest Conference standings.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2011 marked just the fourth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010.

St. Norbert's 77-25 record from 2009 to 2012 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 93-33. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

St. Norbert's 16 wins last season gave the Green Knights a stretch of four consecutive seasons with at least 15 wins, the first time in school history that has happened.

St. Norbert's string of five straight years with at least 10 Midwest Conference wins is also the best mark in school history.

Bouncing Back:

Starting with the 2009-10 season, St. Norbert's men's basketball program has been very resilient following a loss. The Green Knights are 17-2 in the last three-plus seasons in their next game following a loss.

St. Norbert's last two-game losing streak came last season, when the Green Knights lost to UW-La Crosse 78-57 and then fell at Carroll 74-64.

The Green Knights' only other consecutive losses in that stretch were a 79-65 setback to Grinnell and a 57-52 loss at home to Beloit during the 2010-11 season.

St. Norbert is 3-0 this season when following a loss, and was 7-1 last season the next game after a defeat. The Green Knights were 4-1 in 2010-11 and 3-0 in 2009-10.

Jump Shots:

* - In Gary Grzesk's 155-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 24 times, going 24-0 in those games.

* - St. Norbert is 0-2 this season and was 4-5 last season when allowing 70 points or more.
